

Change 1 - to Sailing Instructions

2018 Girts Rekevics Memorial Foul Weather Race

Amendment to Paragraph 3). Paragraph 3 shall be changed to read:

RACE COMMITTEE BOAT: For the start, the designated RC boat will be J/35 SUNSHINE GIRL – she will start all boats at 09:30 GPS time. SUNSHINE GIRL will start 09:35. The designated RC boat will show an Orange Flag to identify itself, and show other signals as indicated above. The Race Committee boat will be on station to observe the start maintaining a position in line with the R2 & Refinery Range marker, but <u>it will NOT</u> be a part of the starting line.

For the finish, there <u>will be no Race Committee boat on station</u>. The finish line will be on a line of bearing between UW Research Pier bearing 330 degrees and the first private dock on the NW shore of Brown Island bearing 150 degrees. Skippers shall record their finish time using local GPS time and report it to the race committee in Friday Harbor within one (1) hour of completing the course. Such reports will be made by texting the Event Chairman and Scorer, John Sanford at (206) 697-0098.

Text format shall be as follows: Boat Name, Sail No., Local Time (HR:MIN:SEC)

(Example: WILD ONE, 23230, 16:44:37)

Amendment to Paragraph 9). Paragraph 9 shall be changed to read:

RACE DETAILS:

Starting Time: Saturday February 25th, 09:30 hours

Start Line: Between R2 & Refinery Pier

Course: Racers shall head outbound (west) down Guemes Channel. Pass through Thatcher's Pass. Leave Lopez Island to Port and Orcas Island to Starboard, enroute to the finish at Friday Harbor, WA.

Finish Line: Entrance to Friday Harbor, on a line of bearing between UW Research Pier bearing 330 degrees and the first private dock on the NW shore of Brown Island bearing 150 degrees. Skippers shall record their finish time using local GPS time and report it to the race committee in Friday Harbor within one (1) hour of completing the course in accordance with the amendment to Paragraph 3).

Time Limit: 17:30 hours (5:30PM). 8 hours elapsed time.

Distance: 19.5nm

Half Way: The half way mark is at the west end of Thatcher Pass and the Red day marker on the starboard side, if headed west. Racers shall record and report halfway times when the red day marker is on a line of bearing of 000 degrees.
