## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 including the US Sailing Prescriptions (“RRS”), except as modified by this Notice of Race (NOR), the Sailing Instructions (SI), and any amendments thereto.
- 1.2 Additionally, one design classes will be governed by their respective class rules.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to one design keel boats, Performance Handicap Racing Fleet (PHRF) boats with Northern California YRA, or Stockton Sailing Club assigned handicap ratings, and dinghy classes with US Sailing Portsmouth ratings.
- 2.2 PHRF boats will be separated into classes based on entries received and performance characteristics of the boats. In an effort to provide ‘like racing’ under PHRF, boat displacement and other factors will be considered when determining class assignments.
- 2.4 Class assignments will be based on entries received by July 12, 2018. One-Design classes not having four (4) entries by this date shall be registered in a PHRF class.
- 2.5 Eligible boats must enter online at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/15878> .

### 3 FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee per boat is one dollar (\$1) per foot of overall boat length.
- 3.2 The minimum entry fee is \$10.
- 3.2 Saturday night dinners are \$10/person.
- 3.5 Entries will receive one (1) dinner ticket for each ten feet of boat length (no rounding up).

### 4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 No entries will be accepted after 0900, Saturday, July 14, 2018.
- 4.2 Skipper’s Meeting will be held in the SSC Clubhouse at 1000, Saturday, July 14, 2018
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1100.
- 4.4 On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 1500.
- 4.5 Results and prizes will be presented in the SSC Clubhouse after the conclusion of racing.
- 4.6 There will be a Cajun-themed dinner and party after the conclusion of racing Saturday.



## **5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be available electronically on the regatta registration site Monday, July 9, 2018.
- 5.2 Division assignments will be available on the registration site after 1313, Friday, July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
- 5.3 Printed copies will be available at the skipper's meeting.

## **6 VENUE**

Racing will take place on the San Joaquin River adjacent to the Stockton Sailing Club.

## **7 THE COURSES**

- 7.1 The courses for One-Design, PHRF, and Portsmouth classes will be of a windward leeward configuration.
- 7.2 Courses will be specified in the Sailing Instructions.

## **8 SCORING**

- 8.1 Low point scoring system, appendix A4 of RRS, will apply.
- 8.2 Five (5) races are scheduled, of which one (1) must be completed to constitute a series for the One-Design, PHRF, and Portsmouth classes.
- 8.3 When five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score (One throw-out).
- 8.4 PHRF Classes will be scored using their handicaps as provided by the Northern California YRA or SSC PHRF committee. All PHRF Classes will be scored using time-on-time scoring.

## **9 PRIZES**

- 9.1 Prizes will be awarded to all participants.
- 9.2 Top finishers in each class will be recognized at the awards presentation.

## **10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
