

NOTICE OF RACE

Flying Scot® 2018 Annual Egyptian Cup Regatta

June 22-24, 2018

Host: The Carlyle Sailing Association (CSA)

Rules: This regatta will be held on Saturday, June 23rd and Sunday, June 24th, 2018. The event will be governed by the 2017-2020 RACING RULES OF SAILING, except as modified by applicable FSSA class rules and/or the Sailing Instructions (available at registration.) Five races are scheduled. One race will constitute a regatta. Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility: The regatta is open to all Flying Scots, you must be a member of FSSA, and membership applications are available at registration.

Registration: Register on line at: <http://www.csa-sailing.org/egypt> or at the regatta site at CSA beginning Friday, June 22nd at 6 pm. Sailing Instructions will be available to registrants at the completion of registration. Registration must be complete by Saturday, June 23rd, at 09:15 a.m.

Measurement: All boats may be checked for safety equipment and sail compliance as required by the FSSA class rules. (see www.fssa-sailing.org).

Fees: The entry fee for the entire program is \$70. Late registration after June 14 will incur an additional \$10 fee. Regatta registration includes **Free on CSA grounds Primitive Camping** in either a tent or single vehicle foot print (car, van, or pickup truck parked in car parking lot). No hookups are available and no pop ups or camping trailers on CSA grounds. Those wishing to camp on CSA grounds will need to check in and get a free permit upon arrival. The regatta fee also includes meals for Skipper and one crew for Friday night Brats and Beer, two breakfasts, two lunches and Saturday evening catered dinner. Additional meals packages can be purchased online or at the registration desk.

Venue: Racing will take place on Carlyle Lake. Launching will be at the Carlyle Sailing Association (CSA). Three hoists are available along with two boat ramps and ample dock space in a well protected harbor. Boats will be stored on trailers on the CSA grounds in the appropriately marked areas. Both car and boat parking lots are paved. CSA has an air conditioned observation building , where meals will be served. There are hot showers available in the restroom building on CSA grounds.

Scoring: No races will be excluded from a boat's series score. This changes RRS rule A2, Appendix A. Low Point Scoring System shall be used. Five races are scheduled, of which one race will constitute a regatta.

Radio Communication: *will be governed by FSSA rule: Art S-V (7)(c)*

Awards: Trophies will be awarded to the skipper and crew as follows:

- Egyptian Cup Regatta: Top finishes
- Egyptian Cup Regatta Champion: The Egyptian Cup perpetual trophy (non traveling)

Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. Neither the organizing authority nor the host organization will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Outside Accommodations & Rentals:

The state park just outside CSA and a nearby federal campground both have hookups for pop-up and trailer camping for a fee on first come first serve basis or by reservation. There are several hotels within a few miles of CSA.
