Sailing Instructions

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta shall be governed by the rules as defined in 2017-2020 *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Each entrant must meet the eligibility, entry and fee requirements as outlined in the Notice of Race.
- 1.3 RRS 26 is changed: The starting signal for one class will be the warning for the next class.
- 1.4 RRS V1 (one turn penalty for incidents outside the zone of a non-starting mark) will apply.
- 1.5 RRS Appendix A 2.1 is amended, no race scores will be excluded. All scores will count.

2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- 2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted by 1000 online and at SCCYC clubhouse.
- 2.2 The Race Committee (RC) may make verbal notices while on the water.

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Any change to the Sailing Instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day of race.

4. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 4.1 Four races are planned for the PHRF and One Design Fleets. Two races are planned for the Cruising and ORCA.
- 4.2 The Warning Signal for the first race shall be at 1255.

5. CLASS FLAGS

- 5.1 Classes and Class Flags will be posted with Notice to Competitors both online and at the clubhouse, see 2.1.

6. RACING AREA

- 6.1 Attachments **2018 Les Storrs Course Chart** shows the location of the racing area.

7. COURSES

- 7.1 PHRF and One-Design will be Windward / Leeward courses chosen from **2018 Les Storrs Course Chart**.
- 7.2 Cruiser and ORCA will be Random Leg Courses chosen from **Cruiser Course Chart**.

8. MARKS

- 8.1 All marks will be Marina del Rey Course Chart 17 yellow spars.
- 8.2 Marks may be replaced by either a yellow or orange inflatable.

9. THE START

- 9.1 A wake-up signal of multiple horns may be sounded as a courtesy approximately one minute before a Warning Signal of an upcoming race.

- 9.2 The Starting Signal for one class will be the Warning Signal for the next class, this changes RRS 26.
- 9.3 Courses will be signaled no later than the Preparatory Signal and remain flying until the start of that class.
- 9.4 The Start Line will be between a pin with an orange flag on the left and an orange flag on the committee boat on the right.

10. THE FINISH

- 10.1 The Finish line will be between a blue flag on the committee boat and an orange inflated ball. It will be on the opposite side of the RC Boat as to the start line.

11. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1 RRS V will apply for an incident that occurs outside the three-boat length zone for a rounding or finishing mark. The penalty shall be one tack and one gybe.

12. TIME LIMIT

- 12.1 There is no time limit; RC will endeavor to finish racing by 1700.

13. PROTEST AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 13.1 Protesting boats are asked to notify the RC at the finish line of their intent to protest.
- 13.2 Protests must be filed at SCCYC within one hour of the RC's return to the Clubhouse.
- 13.3 Expedited hearings are in force.

14. SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 14.1 Check-in: Boats are requested to check in prior to the first Warning Signal.
- 14.2 A boat retiring from racing is requested to notify RC.

15. SCORING

- 15.1 The Les Storrs Regatta will use RRS Appendix A low point scoring.
- 15.2 RRS Appendix A 2.1 is amended, no race scores will be excluded. All scores will count.
- 15.3 For the ASMBYC High Point Series, race number 2 in all classes is the only that will be scored for the High Point Series. See <http://www.asmbyc.org/highpoint/> for more information.

16. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

- 16.1 Race Committee (RC) will monitor and can be contacted via Channel 68 for appropriate communications.
- 16.2 While on the water, changes in the SI, Course, or other communications may be announced by RC via Channel 68.

17. PRIZES

- 17.1 Prizes will be awarded at SCCYC, as soon as possible after racing.
