

### March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018 Waterford Yacht Club and Waterford Harbor Marina, Kemah, Texas SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

#### 1 RULES

This event will be governed by the "Rules" as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2017-20), the prescriptions of US Sailing Association. RRS 26, 29 will not be applicable.

Also USCG Navigation Rules apply, since commercial waters can a part of the race course special attention have to be given to Rule 9 (b).

#### 2. ENTRIES

Competitors may enter the Regatta by completing the Registration Form and turning it in by Friday March 23, 2018. Competitors will race in the PHRF class with ratings assigned as per the race committee per PHRF database. This rating will be used to calculate the corrected race time.

#### 3. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to Competitors will be posted on the official Race Information Notice Board located in the Ice House at the Waterford Harbor Marina between Piers 14 and 15.

#### 4. CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change to these sailing instructions shall be posted before noon before the day it will take effect. Any change to the Schedule of Races will be posted by 2000 hours (8:00 PM) on the day before it will take effect.

#### 5. **IDENTIFICATION**

Each boat will check in prior to the Start on VHF channel 68.

#### 6. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

There will not be any signals from shore.

#### 7. SCHEDULE OF RACES

Races will be sailed according to the schedule in the Notice of Race, unless changed by the provisions of paragraph 4 of these Sailing Instructions. All times are GPS times.

#### 8. RACE AREA

The race will be sailed around fixed marks in the area of Galveston Jetties, and the Gulf of Mexico

- 8.1. The mark layout is shown in the Appendix:
  - <u>Start</u>
    - The Start line will be **Galveston "5A" End of South Jetty**
    - Approximate Location: 29º 19.638' N 094 41.274' W
  - Keep mark to starboard record start time when "5A" is bearing 270 degrees (West).
  - Course to first mark (approximate)
  - 178 True 176 Magnetic 11.07 nm
  - First Mark
    - Fish Haven FR-TX-25 (also known as the "12 mile rig" platforms removed, now sea floor artificial reef)
    - Fl Y 6s (yellow barrel buoy) Private
    - Approximate Location: 29 08.574' N 094 40.834' W
  - Course to finish (approximate)
  - 248° True 246° Magnetic 34.19 nm
  - <u>Finish</u>
    - Freeport "6" Red buoy
    - Fl R 2.5s (red barrel buoy)
    - Approximate Location: 28 55.430' N095 16.930' W
  - Keep Mark on Starboard, Record finish time when Freeport buoy "6" is starboard bearing 0 (due north) stay clear of ship channel traffic.

#### 9. THE COURSE and MARKS

The course will be sailed from the Start line (Mark #5A) and then to First Mark (Fish Haven Yellow Barrel Buoy), then to Finish (Freeport Red 6 buoy). After crossing start line, all marks are to be left to Starboard. The race course is approximately 45.26 NM.

#### 10. THE START

10.1 The Start time is between 9:00 and 10:30 hour (9-10:30AM) and all competitors will record their own start time. The GPS time of that moment has to be broadcast on **VHF channel 68** and confirmed by the Race Committee boat (or other participants if Race Committee boat unavailable). Log this time in the sailing log.

#### 11. RECALLS

There will be no recalls; all boats will start on the honor system. In case of a dispute about the start time, the time of the race committee boat will be the used time.

#### 12. CHANGE OF THE POSITION OF THE NEXT MARK

13.1. No change to the Marks will be made.

#### 13. THE FINISH

The finish line will be the line where the compass bearing of marker 6 is 0 degree. At that moment the finishing boat will announce this time on channel 68 and log this time in the sailing log.

#### 14. TIME LIMIT

The time limit is March 30<sup>th</sup> at 22:00 hour (10PM).

#### **15. PENALTIES**

A boat that has taken her Penalty Turns shall notify the Race Committee via **VHF channel 68** at the first reasonable opportunity. At that time she shall also inform the Race Committee of the identity of the other boat involved in the incident.

#### 16. **PROTESTS**

- 16.1. Intent to protest shall be signaled in accordance with RRS. The protesting boat shall also notify the Race Committee and be acknowledged before leaving the finish area.
- 16.2 A protested boat can clear itself on the water by making a penalty turn an in RRS 2017-2020 appendix B 44.
- 16.3 Protests shall be written on forms available at the Freeport Marina and delivered there within two hours following the arrival in the harbor of the Race Committee member.
- 16.4. The times and locations of the protest hearings, along with the names of the boats involved will be posted.

#### 17. SCORING

The boat with shortest corrected sailed time is the winner

#### **18. SAFETY**

18.1. Any boat that has checked in, and then withdraws before finishing the race, shall notify the Race Committee on the water, or, if that is not possible, the Waterford Yacht Club race committee chair (Doug Catenaci) at 713-517-4184 or (Dennis Stetzel) 281-216-4086 or VHF Channel 68.




- 18.3 When the Y flag is displayed on the race committee boat all competitors shall wear personal flotation devices. See RRS part 4 rule 40.
- 18.4 Any boat which interferes with commercial ship traffic in the Houston or Freeport Ship Channel during the race will be disqualified.

#### **19. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS**

- 19.1 A yacht shall neither make radio transmissions while racing, nor receive special radio communications not available to all yachts. This does not apply to situations that threaten safety of life and/or property.
- 19.2 The Race Committee will monitor **VHF channel 68** for the Pursuit Line and in the case of abandonment of the race.
- 19.3 It is highly advised to use the (free) app RaceQs for race tracking.







Keep mark to starboard - record start time when "5A" is bearing 270 degrees (West).Course to first mark (approximate)178° True 176° Magnetic11.07 nm




Course to finish (approximate)248° True 246° Magnetic34.19 nm





**Record finish time when Freeport buoy "6" is starboard bearing 0 (due north) – stay clear of ship channel traffic.**
