

## CLUB RACING REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT

Each boat participating in club racing must at all times carry the minimum safety equipment required by Transport Canada listed below. To demonstrate compliance with this regulation, each skipper/owner must have his/her boat inspected by another skipper in the same fleet. The inspecting skipper must check off all items listed below which are on the boat and that they are in good working condition. Only if all items for the appropriate length of boat are checked, is the inspecting skipper to sign the form. The boat owner/skipper is then to also sign the form and submit it to the statistician.

Boats not having submitted a completed form by April 30 will not have their race results recorded until a completed form is submitted. Race results between April 30 and the time a completed form is submitted will not be credited to the boat in question.

Further RANDOM inspections may be made during the remainder of the year. Failure to pass such an inspection will result in that day's and/or any subsequent race results for that boat prior to the resubmission of a completed safety equipment form not being recorded or credited to that boat. Upon receipt of a completed safety equipment list, subsequent race results will again be recorded and credited.

### Up to 6m (19'8")

- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) lifejacket or PFD for each person on board
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) buoyant heaving line at least 15 m (49'3") long
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) reboarding device if freeboard is over 0.5 m (1'8")
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) bailer or manual bilge pump
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) watertight flashlight
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) sound-signaling device or appliance
- \_\_\_\_\_ \*\*Navigation lights
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) 5BC fire extinguisher if equipped with an inboard engine, a fixed fuel tank of any size, or a fuel-burning cooking, heating or refrigerating appliance
- \_\_\_\_\_ **FUNCTIONIAL VHF RADIO**

### 6 m and up to 9 m (19'8" - 29'6")

- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) lifejacket or PFD for each person on board
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) buoyant heaving line at least 15 m (49'3") long
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) reboarding device if freeboard is over 0.5 m (1'8")
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) anchor and at least 15 m (49'3") of cable, rope or chain in any combination
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) bailer or manual bilge pump
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) watertight flashlight
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) sound-signaling device or appliance
- \_\_\_\_\_ \*\*Navigation lights
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) 5BC fire extinguisher if equipped with a motor
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) 5BC fire extinguisher if equipped with a fuel-burning cooking, heating or refrigerating appliance
- \_\_\_\_\_ **FUNCTIONIAL VHF RADIO**

\*\*Only required if the boat is operated after sunset, before sunrise or in periods of restricted visibility (fog, falling snow, etc.).

Appendix B

**9 m and up to 12 m (29'6" – 39'4")**

- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) lifejacket or PFD for each person on board
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) buoyant heaving line at least 15 m (49'3") long
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) lifebuoy attached to a buoyant line at least 15 m (49'3") long
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) reboarding device if freeboard is over 0.5 m (1'8")
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) anchor and at least 30 m (98'5") of cable, rope or chain in any combination
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) manual bilge pump OR Bilge-pumping arrangements
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) watertight flashlight
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) sound-signaling device or appliance
- \_\_\_\_\_ \*\*Navigation lights
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) magnetic compass
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) 10BC fire extinguisher if equipped with a motor
- \_\_\_\_\_ One (1) 10BC fire extinguisher if equipped with a fuel-burning cooking, heating or refrigerating appliance
- \_\_\_\_\_ **FUNCTIONAL VHF RADIO**

\*\*Only required if the boat is operated after sunset, before sunrise or in periods of restricted visibility (fog, falling snow, etc.).
