Sunday June 10, 2018 Race #5 – West End to MDR
Sailing Instructions

1 RULES

- . 1.1 This race shall be governed by the “*rules*” as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- . 1.2 RRS 51 and 52 are changed as follows: movable ballast is allowed; non-manual power may be used to move ballast; all movable ballast systems shall be capable of manual operation.
- . 1.3 PHRF of So. California Rule #8 (Marine Industry Racer-MIR) does not apply. Anyone that satisfies the definition of “MIR” may not steer a boat in the “Stein” series.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- . 2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the Bulletin Board no later than 0900 each race day. The RC will attempt to post Notices on the DRYC website. (www.dryc.org)
- . 2.2 For Race #4 the Bulletin Board will be inside the DRYC clubhouse.
For Race #5 the Bulletin Board will be on the stage at the DRYC island facility.

3 SCHEDULE; CLASSES AND CLASS FLAGS

- . 3.1 The flags and order of starts will be posted on the DRYC Notice Board and website no later than 1800 Friday June 8.
- . 3.2 The Warning Signal for the first start will be made at 1155 Saturday and at 1155 Sunday.

4 RACE# 4 COURSE AND MARKS

4.1 Berger Course- From the starting line, leave the El Segundo bell buoy (2ES) to port. Leave the West End of Catalina Island to port and continue to the finishing line. (See attached diagram)

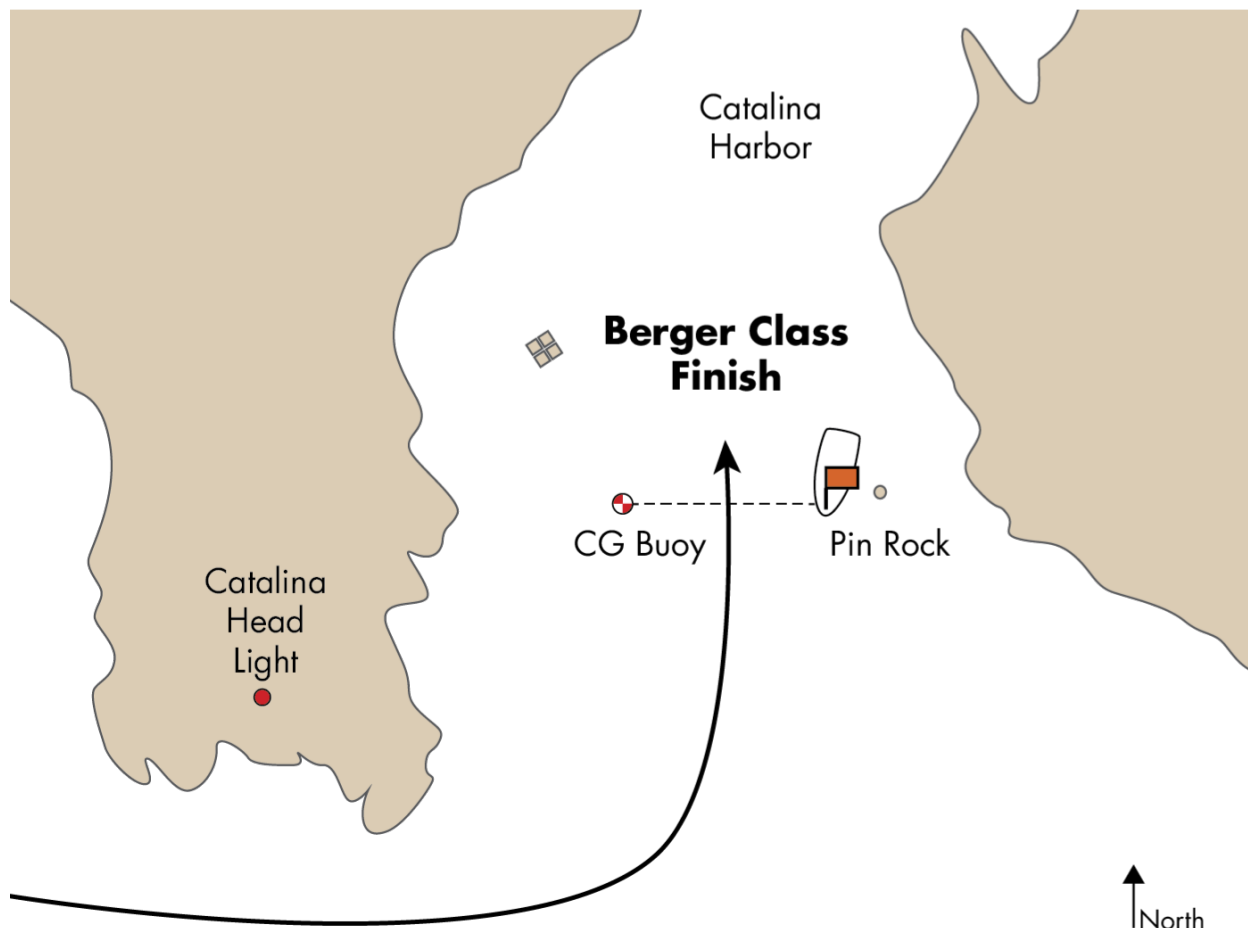
4.2 Stein Course- From the starting line, leave the El Segundo bell buoy (2ES) to port and continue to the finishing line. (See attached diagram)

5 THE START- ALL CLASSES

5.1 The starting line will be between H mark or an inflatable buoy if H mark is missing (see MDR Course Chart 17) at the left hand end and an Orange flag on the RC boat at the other end.

5.3 Races shall be started as provided in RRS 26, except the Starting Signal for each class shall be the Warning Signal for the next class.

5.4 The RC will attempt to announce starting information and recalls on VHF 68.



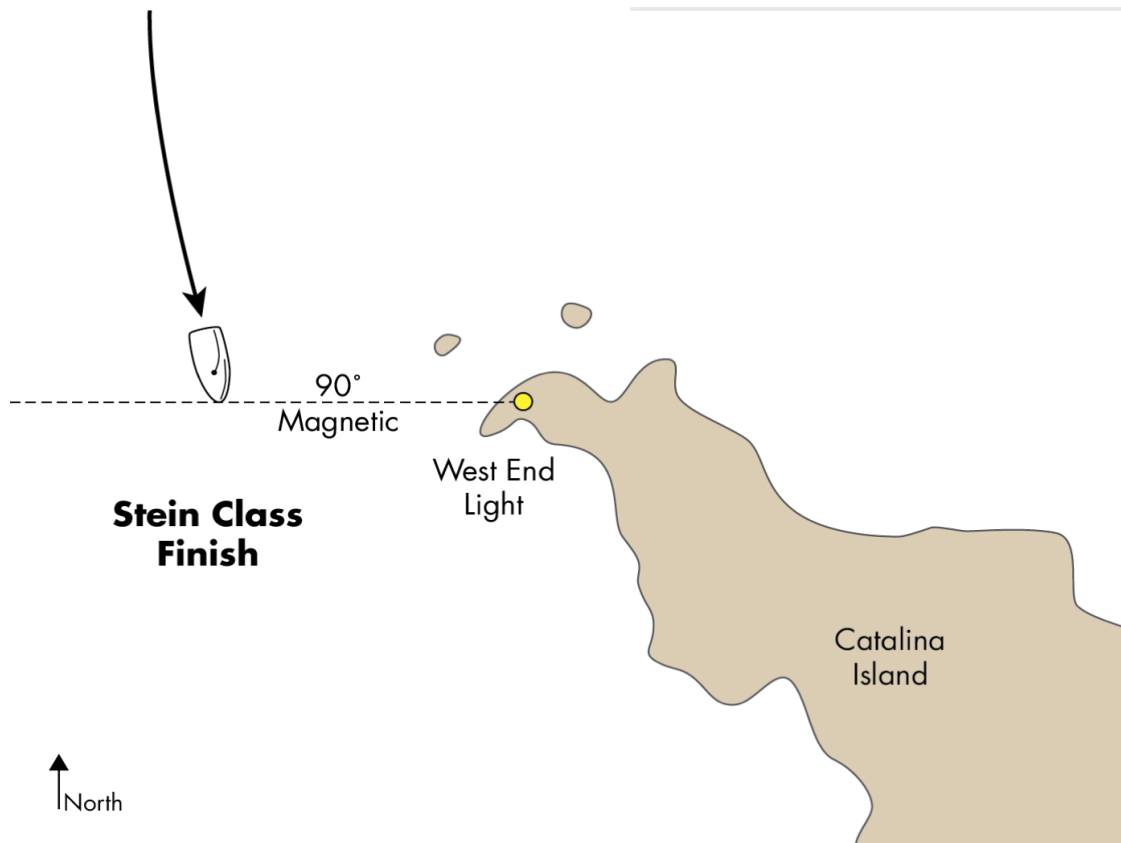
6 THE FINISH

6.1 **Berger Finish**-The finishing line will be between the Coast Guard buoy and an Orange flag on the RC boat. (See diagram) Please hail the RC on 68 when entering the harbor.

6.2 Record your finish time and boats that finish ahead and behind.(See attached finish sheet)

6.3 If approaching the finishing line after dark, boats shall notify the RC on VHF 68 as they approach the finishing line and shall illuminate their sail number as they finish.

- 6.4 The RC intends to be on station until 2030. If the RC is not on station, take your own finish time (GPS) when your bow crosses an imaginary line between the Coast Guard buoy and Pin Rock. Record boats ahead and behind. (See attached finish sheet)
- 6.5 **Stein Finish-** The finishing line, will be between the Catalina “West End” light and the bow of your boat.
- 6.6 When the light bears 90° from your bow, each boat shall record and announce their GPS finish time on VHF 68 when entering the harbor. Record boats ahead and behind. (See attached finish sheet)



7 RACE #5 COURSE AND MARKS

7.1 Berger and Stein Classes- From the starting line leave the El Segundo bell buoy (2ES) to starboard.

7.2 Round the **Yellow** inflatable mark **to port** located to the south of the MDR detached breakwater at approximately:

33°57'22.00" N 118°27'30.00" W (Degrees-Minutes-Seconds)

33°57.367 N 118°27.500 W (Degrees-Minutes-Decimal)

The RC will attempt to have a strobe on this mark.

7.3 Proceed to the finish line.

8 THE START- ALL CLASSES

- . **8.1** The starting line will be between an orange flag on the RC boat at the left hand end and the summit of Eagle Rock (approx. 0.5 nm from the West End of Catalina Island).
- . **8.2** Races shall be started as provided in RRS 26, except the Starting Signal for each class shall be the Warning Signal for the next class.
- . **8.3** The RC will attempt to announce starting information and recalls on VHF 68.



9 THE FINISH- ALL CLASSES

- . **9.1** The finishing line will be between the green light on the South End of the Marina del Rey detached breakwater and an Orange flag on the Race Committee boat. (See diagram)
- . **9.2** Record your finish time (GPS) and note boats that finish ahead and behind. (See attached finish sheet)
- . **9.3** If approaching the finishing line after dark, boats shall notify the RC on VHF 68 as they approach the finishing line and shall illuminate their sail numbers as they finish.
- . **9.4** The RC boat intends to be on station until 1900. If the RC is not on station, take your own finish time (GPS) when the green light on the South End of the Marina del Rey detached breakwater bears 200° from your bow.

10 PROTESTS

- . **10.1** Boats shall notify the RC of their intention to protest within two hours after finishing, either in person at DRYC or via the contact phone numbers in **SI 15**.
- . **10.2** Protests shall be filed at DRYC no later than 1200 June 11, 2018 (Protest Time Limit) Hearings will be scheduled for a later date.

11 HANDICAP RATINGS / SCORING

- . **11.1** Race #4- The course length for the Berger is 36.5 nm and for the Stein is 29.5 nm.
- . **11.2** Race #5- The course length for all classes for Race #5 is 30 nm.
- . **11.3 Berger**, PHRF Area B RLC ratings will be used. ORCA ratings will be used. Stein, PHRF Area B Corinthian RLC ratings will be used.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

The RC will attempt to monitor and announce starting information and recalls on VHF 68.
