NOTICE OF RACE

1. AUTHORITY & RULES

The race will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 - 2020, the rules of PHRF of Southeast Florida, and the rules of any One Design classes competing, this Notice of Race, Sailing Instructions, and rating conversion factors by US Sailing's standards.

2. ELIGIBILITY

The regatta is open to all self-rescuing sailboats minimum 15' LOA, minimum crew of two people. All entries must carry an operating VHF radio. Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form on the Regatta Network website at www.regattanetwork.com

3. CLASSES

Entrants are eligible to register for ONE of the following Classes:

1. PHRF with Spinnaker (PHRF of Southeast Florida rating required)
2. Cruising Jib and Main
3. True cruising multihulls
4. Performance cruising multihulls
5. Day-sailing keelboats
6. Day-sailing dinghies
7. Beach multihulls



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4. ENTRIES

4.1 The Race Committee reserves the right to accept or reject an entry of any yacht at any time prior to the start of the race.

4.2 Entry Fee: \$50.00 per vessel – cut-off is 7:00 pm Wed. March 14, 2017. Entries are through the Regatta Network website **only** – www.regattanetwork.com

5. SCHEDULE

Mandatory Competitor's Meeting - Fri Mar 16th, 7:00 pm at Palm Beach Sailing Club

Warning for first start - Sat Mar 17th at 11:55 am

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions showing the course to be sailed and starting time assignments will be distributed at the Skipper's Meeting.

7. COURSE TO BE SAILED

The race is scheduled to be 12 nautical miles in length with multiple points of sail.

8. SCORING / AWARDS

8.1 As this is a pursuit start, a yacht's finish position determines her score.

8.2 An overall award will be given to the first finisher.

8.3 Class awards will be given to each class with 3 or more registrants.

8.4 A special PERFORMANCE CONTRIBUTOR AWARD will be given based on contributions received on behalf of particular entrant by **9 pm Friday, March 16**. For each \$1 contributed, 1 sec. will be deducted from a finisher's time! **Contribute via the GOFUNDME site.**
