NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 Racing shall be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The notation "[NP]" in a rule in this NoR means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 This race is open to boats of the following classes:

PHRF A0/A1	PHRF N	J/30
PHRF A2	Alberg 30	J/35
PHRF B	Cal 25	J/105
PHRF C	J/24

2.3 Additional classes will be accepted upon the receipt of six (6) or more paid entries by 2000 hours on Sunday, 20 May 2018.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The fee is:
 - \$45 for paid entries received by 2000 hours on Saturday, 19 May 2018.
 - \$60 for paid entries received after 2000 hours on Saturday, 19 May 2018, but before 1200 hours on Friday, 25 May 2018.
- 3.2 A 50% entry fee refund will be provided if a request to withdraw from the race is received by 2000 hours on Sunday, 20 May 2018.

4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1 The schedule of events is:

4.2 There will be a mandatory check-in requirement for all competitors prior to their start.

4.3 The starting order will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6 VENUE

- 6.1 Racing will be on the Miles River, Eastern Bay, and Chesapeake Bay.
- 6.2 A post-race party and awards presentation will be held at the EYC clubhouse after the conclusion of racing.

7 COURSE

The course will be a point-to-point race between St. Michael's and Annapolis.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1 RRS Appendix V1, Penalty at the Time of An Incident, will apply.
- 8.2 RRS Appendix V2, Penalty Taken After A Race, will apply, and is changed to: "After a race, a boat that may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 or RRS 31 in an incident while racing may take a Post-Race Penalty for that incident. A boat takes the penalty by delivering a written notice to the race office or sending an email to <u>race.committee@eastportyc.org</u> that identifies the race number and when and where the incident occurred. The penalty shall be calculated as stated in RRS 44.3(c). The written notice must be delivered at least fifteen (15) minutes before the protest time limit.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 RRS A4, the Low Point scoring system will apply.
- 9.2 Handicap scoring will be in accordance with the PHRF Time-on-Time Circular Random rating.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Prizes in each class will be as follows:
 - 1st Place for six (6) or more entries;
 - 2nd Place for seven (7) or more entries;
 - 3rd Place for nine (9) or more entries;
 - 4th Place for eleven (11) or more entries.
- 10.2 Prizes will be awarded during a party at EYC on Sunday, 27 May 2018.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the Miles River Race Back entirely at their own risk; see RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

12 INSURANCE

[NP] Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.
