# Notice of Race - Updated

The Hudson Yacht Club and the Montreal area J22 fleet invite all J/22 Skippers and Crews to participate in the 2018 J22 Canadian Championship. This regatta on the Lake of Two Mountains will offer great hospitality and lots of great racing in a beautiful setting, in the town of Hudson, Québec, about 45 minutes from downtown Montreal.

#### 1. RULES:

Racing during this event will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

1. All prescriptions will be stated in full in the Sailing Instructions.

# 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

This regatta is open to all J22 boats and crews meeting all class membership and measurement requirements. Participants must have completed registration and paid all event fees before beginning official competition. Please pre-register to assist in regatta planning.

### 3. ENTRY FEE:

The entry fee of **CDN \$120** per boat, including all taxes, covers the clinic, all racing, harbour, launch and haulout facilities, a hot dinner for all participants on Friday night, trophies, and other goodies....... This fee does not include the cash bar or any additional meals.

We are planning a Regatta dinner and entertainment on Saturday night (not included in Registration Fee). Information will be available during registration, and payment for dinners will be at the registration desk at HYC.

# **5. NUMBER OF RACES:**

There will be a maximum of 7 races for the regatta, no maximum or minimum number each day, but no starting sequence after 1400 on Sunday. There will be a minimum of 3 races sailed to constitute a regatta.

# 6. SCORING:

The low point scoring system of Appendix A of the RRS will apply (as modified by the Sailing Instructions). A yacht's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races counted. If five or more races are completed, the worst race score for each yacht will be discarded.

# 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The sailing instructions will be available at Check In and will be posted online on the Regatta Network.

# **8. COACHES AND COACH BOATS:**

Mike Marshall will be in the only on-water coach boat allowed for the regatta. Mike will be taking videos for discussion at the Dock Talk at the end of the day. No other coach or private support boats will be allowed.

#### 9. PRIZES AND AWARDS:

Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers. Additional prizes will depend upon the number of competitors in the fleet, and will be announced at registration.

#### 10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

Athletes are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility. It is for athletes to decide whether their boat is fit to sail in the conditions in which it will find itself. By launching or going to sea athletes confirm the boat is fit for those conditions and they are competent to sail and compete in them. Nothing done by the organizers can reduce the responsibility of the owners and/or athletes, nor will it make the organizers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organizers encompass everyone helping to run the event. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve owners and athletes of their responsibilities. Competitors also agree to be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing and by all other rules that govern this event.

# 11. PHOTO AND VIDEO DISCLAIMER

By participating in the event, competitors give absolute right and permission for any photograph and video footage taken of themselves or the boat they are sailing during the event, to be published in any media whatsoever, for either editorial or advertising purposes or to be used in press information without compensation.
