NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 Racing shall be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The notation “[DP]” in a rule in this Notice of Race (NoR) means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the Protest Committee, be less than disqualification.
- 1.3 The notation “[NP]” in a rule in this NoR means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 [DP] This race is open to boats with a PHRF rating.
- 2.2 There will be two classes: Non-Spinnaker and Spinnaker.
- 2.3 Registration will be available online no later than Sunday, 11 March 2018, at the Eastport Yacht Club (EYC) website: <http://eastportyc.org/leftover-bowl>. Registrations may also be mailed to:

3 FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$40. Paid entries must be received by 1300 hours on Friday, 23 November 2018.
- 3.2 A 50% entry fee refund will be provided if a request to withdraw from the race is received by 2000 hours on Saturday, 17 November 2018.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

[NP] The Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than Saturday, 10 November 2018, and posted on the Official Notice Board at the EYC clubhouse.

6 VENUE

- 6.1 The racing area will be on the Severn River.
- 6.2 Post-race activities will be held at the EYC clubhouse.

7 COURSES

Competitors will sail one (1) fixed mark course on the Severn River as described in the Sailing Instructions.

8 PENALTIES

- 8.1 RRS Appendix V1, Penalty at the Time of An Incident, will apply.
- 8.2 RRS Appendix V2, Penalty Taken After A Race, will apply, and is changed to: "After a race, a boat that may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 or RRS 31 in an incident while racing may take a Post-Race Penalty for that incident. A boat takes the penalty by delivering a written notice to the race office or sending an email to race.committee@eastportyc.org that identifies the race number and when and where the incident occurred. The penalty shall be calculated as stated in RRS 44.3(c). The written notice must be delivered at least fifteen (15) minutes before the protest time limit.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 RRS A4, the Low Point scoring system will apply.
- 9.2 Handicap scoring will be in accordance with the PHRF Time-on-Time Circular Random rating.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Prizes are based on leftover and unclaimed trophies from the previous year(s) – hence, the name of the event. Prizes will be at the discretion of the Race Committee, based on the amount of leftovers.
- 10.2 The EYC Golden Shoes award will be presented to the best-dressed boat/crew.
- 10.3 An awards & chili party will be held at EYC approximately one (1) hour after the last boat to finish.
- 10.4 Guests are welcome at EYC.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the Leftover Bowl entirely at their own risk; see RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

12 INSURANCE

[NP] Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.
