**1. RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, and the sailing instructions.

**2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

2.1 This regatta will be open to the classes: El Toro A, B, C, C2, C3, C4, Laser A & B, O'pen Bic U13 & U17.

2.2 Participants must be current members of HYSA and under 23 years old on the day of the regatta.

2.3 Entry fee will be \$10 for US Sailing members and \$12 for non-members. Registration will be on-line at [www.regattanetwork.com](http://www.regattanetwork.com). A \$5 late fee will be charged for entry received after 8:00 pm on March 16, 2018.

**5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS - Saturday March 17, 2018**

1100 First Race, Race 2-5 immediately following. No race will start later than 1430.

**6. SCORING**

The race will be scored according to the low point scoring system, appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing. Each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, discarding her worst score if, five (5) or more races are completed.

**7. NUMBER OF RACES**

Five (5) races will be attempted but the regatta will be scored based on the number of races completed within the allotted time.

**8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be posted at the skipper's meeting.

**9. ALTERATIONS IN RACING RULES**

Rule (61.1 a) has been modified in that a flag is not required to lodge protest.

**10. COURSE**

The courses to be sailed will be hailed from the race committee boat before each race.

**11. PROTESTS**

Protests must be filed within one half hour after the race committee boat docks.

**12. AWARDS**

The top three boats in each class will receive awards.
