#### RULES

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2021, Sailing Instructions and notices will be posted on the official bulletin board in front hall of clubhouse.

#### NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices and changes to Sailing Instructions will be posted on the official bulletin board located in the club house.

## **SKIPPERS' MEETING**

The skippers' meeting will be held in the clubhouse at 0915. (Not Mandatory)

# COURSES

Region 3 Choptank Area Standard Racing Marks will be used. Course will be designated by letters displayed on the end of the floating dock.

The course can be shortened or changed at the discretion of the Race Committee PRO. All changes will be completed at a designated rounding mark of the identified course. If this occurs the Race Committee will notify yachts via radio and if shortened, be on station at the mark in the case of finish.

# START

Races will be Club starts. The starting line will be between the orange flag on TAYC upper deck

Revised 5/17/17 KM and the nearby orange starting mark.

## RECALLS

**Individual Recalls** will be signaled by code flag "X" (White with blue cross) and one horn blast. The committee will attempt to hail the sail number(s) of the premature starter(s). Whether or not the hail is heard, responsibility for starting properly rests with each yacht.

**General Recall** will be signaled by display of code flag "First Substitute" (yellow and blue pennant) and two guns or horn blasts. Class start order will remain intact and recalled class will restart.

## TIME LIMIT:

The time limit for each of Saturday's races shall be 3 hours with all yachts needing to finish within 30 minutes of first yacht in the fleet to finish. The time limit for Sunday's race shall be 4 hrs with all yachts needing to finish within 45 minutes of the first yacht in the fleet to finish. Yachts shall finish within her designated time limit. Failure to finish within the time limit shall result in a DNF for that race without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5.

#### FINISH

The finish line will be between R-2 and the TAYC upper deck. In the case of a changed or shortened course the finish will be between the mark and orange flag on the committee boat.

#### PROTESTS

A yacht desiring to protest must notify the other contestants involved. The protesting yacht shall notify the race committee boat at the finish line and receive acknowledgment. A written protest must be filed with the Race Committee within one hour after the committee boat returns to the dock. Time and location of protest meetings will be posted on the official bulletin board.

#### SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A will

apply for the race series. PHRF Handicap applies. One race shall be completed to constitute a series.

## AWARDS

Awards will be presented at the clubhouse after the final race on June 3rd. Awards will be made for 2 classes - 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>.
