Finish: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and a drop mark or government mark in

immediate vicinity of Race Committee boat. If shortened, all classes finish between a

mark of the original course and orange flag on Race Committee boat.

Time Limit: 3 hours per race.

Protests: Written protests must be delivered to the Race Committee Chairman within one hour

after the Race Committee Boat docks. Protests will be heard as soon as possible after

completion of races.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5 & 3rd/7+ finishers will be awarded. Winners will be recognized and asked to
