First Amendment Sailing Instructions D.J.JOHNSON AROUND OAHU REGATTA

May 26th, 27th, 28th, 2018

Race Q. This is neither mandatory nor affecting any result of your score, however, it is requested all the competitors have the Race Q on while racing during these three days. We are still in an experiment stage of the use of Race Q and your cooperation is appreciated. The instruction how to register to our race will be emailed to each entrant within May 25, 2018.

APPENDIX A May 26, 2018 Day 1

The Finish: The finish is at Kaneohe Bay Sampan channel entrance. The finish line is between the Sampan Channel entrance buoy R2 and the Race Committee Boat with orange flag. Boats may communicate on VHF Channel 68 with KYC Race Committee to verify their finish times. Boats finishing when the Race Committee is not on station shall finish (starboard to R2, 315 degree to R2 and within 100 yards to R2) and report their finish times to the Race Committee, on VHF Channel 68 or by contacting KYC Brett Phillips at (808) 388-3456 within one hour of finishing.

APPENDIX B May 27, 2018 Day 2 **The Course:** The course will be Start – Mark X to port – Out the main channel honoring all marks except "K" – DH to starboard - Finish. Boats shall pass all island to seaward, except Moku Manu, which may be passed on either side. Approx. 39 NM.

The Start: The Start will be between KYC and Coconut Island. The Start Line will be between a starting pin and a rectangular white flag with the letters L I N E (alternatively an orange flag) on the Race Committee signal boat.

The Finish: The finish line will be between G1 (Ala Wai Harbor Channel entrance buoy) and the staff of an orange flag on the Race Committee Boat. Boats finishing when the Race Committee is not on station shall finish (starboard to G1, 0 degree to G1 and within 100 yards to G1) and report their finish times to WYC Race Committee on VHF Channel 68 or (808) 391-7940 as soon as possible.

APPENDIX C May 28, 2018 Day 3

The Course:

The course will be Start – DH to port – Orange tetrahedron mark to be placed off Ewa beach to port – Finish. Approx 29 NM.

Orange tetrahedron mark off Ewa beach will be located approx. N21 17.024, W158 03.387 or within 300 yards of those GPS coordinates. This is the similar place that Hawaii Yacht Club placed the orange tetrahedron mark while Spring Pokai Regatta was held on March 17, 2018. If Orange tetrahedron is missing out of position, the race committee boat may substitute for the mark with flag "M" in accordance with RRS 34. RC will inform GPS coordinates upon placement of orange tetrahedron mark via VHF Channel 68.

The Finish: The finish line will be between G1 (Ala Wai Harbor Channel entrance buoy) and the staff of an orange flag on the Race Committee Boat. Boats finishing when the Race Committee is not on station shall finish (port to G1, 0 degree to G1 and within 100 yards to G1) and report their finish times to WYC Race Committee on VHF Channel 68 or (808) 391-7940 as soon as possible.
