The Rules

- 1. The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Sailing Instructions will govern the Racing.
- 2. Any seaworthy sailing vessel that has an auxiliary engine is eligible. It is the responsibility of the Master of the vessel to determine its seaworthiness.
- 3. Each vessel shall have a crew of not less than 2 persons and carry a VHF radio.

Entry & Fees

- 1. Entry Fees shall be paid to the Palm Beach Sailing Club no later than June 7, 2018. Registration via Regatta Network at: http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/16785 (then follow links on event site for registration)
- 2. Entry Fees: Early Registration by May 10 \$30; Regular Registration by June 1 \$50; Late Registration June 1 June 7 \$80. Fees based on date paid.
- 3. This Fee will include one dinner ticket.
- 4. Additional dinners can be purchased for \$25. Contact PBSC via office@pbsail.org or 561-881-0809 to purchase additional dinners. On June 7 the dinner fee increases to \$35 per person -- subject to availability.
- 5. Cancellations made before June 1 will be refundable and must be done by contacting fleetcaptain@pbsail.org via email, or phone 561-275-3910.

Classes & Rating

- 1. There will be 5 classes: Assigned Rating Class (ARC), Corinthian, JAM, and Multihull (MUL), and Gunkhole (GNK).
- 2. The Race committee will assign ratings to unrated vessels. Their decision on ratings will be final
- 3. The ARC class will be the performance racing class.
- 4. The Corinthian class will be for cruisers who wish to carry downwind specialty sails including spinnakers.
- 5. The JAM classes will be a jib and main only classes.
- 6. The MUL class is for cruising catamarans only.
- 7. The Gunkhole Class (GNK) all levels of cruisers who want to race good for first time racers Jib and Main only.
- 8. Results will be calculated using the HISC proprietary scoring system the handicap distance of the race will be 25 miles.
