

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

PSA – Race to Rock Hall

Oct. 6, 2018

1. **Rules** - The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
2. **Notice to Competitors** - Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the regatta website.
3. **Signals Made Ashore** - No signals will be made ashore. To contact RC on the day of the race, Ed Poe (410) 916-0325.
4. **Schedule and Class Flags** - The first warning signal will be 10:55. The intention is to roll the starts. It is the skipper's responsibility to identify the proper Class flag. The order of starts and class flags are:
 - Short Course
 - CRCA-ARC Yellow flag - Spin, Pink flag-NS
 - Alberg 30 "G" flag
 - Multihull B "F" flag
 - CRCA -ORR White flag
 - PHRF B/C #6 pennant – B, #7 pennant – C
 - Long Course
 - PHRF A #9 pennant
 - Multihull A "W" flag
5. **Courses** - The intended courses are shown below, at its discretion the RC may announce others by posting on the signal boat.
 - Short Course – 8.48 nm – T (start), E (port), C (stb), W (finish)
 - Long Course – 10.22 nm – T (start), E (port), C (stb), X (port), W (finish)
6. **Time Limit** - This changes the NOR – There is no time limit – Any boat reaching the finish line after the RC has departed shall record their finish time when they are close abeam the mark and report its finish time to Lanny Helms (301) 922-2092
7. **Protests** – Any boat intending to protest must notify the Finish Line boat. Detailed information on filing protests and hearing are in the NOR.
