The Santana 20 and Geary 18 Classes will sail races 1, 2 and 3 of their respective class events on Friday July 27th and will then join the Southern Cascade Regatta Saturday and Sunday as a class to complete their series.

Additional information on the Santana 20 Class Championship is posted in the S20 NOR on the Regatta Network site. This document will serve as the Geary 18 NOR.

All classes are welcome and we look forward to seeing you! Howard Prairie offers family friendly camping and fishing, as well as amazing spectator views of racing from the jetty at the resort. Join us for a great summer weekend of sailing! RYC has again reserved Apserkaha Campground at the south end of the lake for 5 nights, Wednesday 7/25 through Sunday 7/29. Cabins, RV spaces and campsites will be reserved through RYC as part of the registration process. The campground has a large commercial kitchen, showers, rustic scout camp type cabins, tent sites and RV sites with water and electric hook-ups. We will do our best to accommodate everyone regarding lodging availability and preferences. Participants are not required to stay at Apserkaha and may stay in the county campgrounds adjacent to Howard Prairie Resort, however RYC's pricing structure at Apserkaha will save you some bucks and allow you time to socialize with your fellow sailors. All boats should launch at the main ramp at Howard Prairie Resort. Launching for small boats on dollies (like Lasers) may be done from Apserkaha although this is not recommended. The final awards ceremony will be held at the RYC storage shed adjacent to the marina after Sunday's racing concludes. The resort will have overnight in the water moorage available, or dry storage on your trailer in the parking lot adjacent to the launch ramp at discounted rates payable in the marina office. Boats on dollies may also be safely stored in the grass near the RYC storage shed. Race committee operations will be run out of the resort marina. After racing it is a short 5 minute drive to Apserkaha.

Sailing Instructions and the Course Map are posted on the Regatta Network event site and will be in your registration packets upon pick-up.

Because the Regatta is also hosting Santana 20 and Geary 18 Class events, there are separate registration forms and fee structures due to the extra day(s) of racing for those events.

The Santana 20 registration fee is \$195 and includes class sponsored Thursday night burgers, 3 Saturday night dinners and 3 Sunday breakfasts. Lodging, Friday night dinners, any additional Saturday dinners or Sunday breakfasts will need to be purchased separately at checkout. Participants may check in at Apserkaha beginning Wednesday, July 25th after 4:00 PM.

The Geary 18 registration fee is \$125 and **includes 2 Saturday night dinners.** Lodging, Friday night dinners, any additional Saturday dinners or Sunday breakfasts will need to be purchased separately at checkout. Participants may check in at Apserkaha beginning Thursday, July 26th after 12:00 PM.

The Southern Cascade Regatta registration fee is \$65 and includes **1 Saturday night dinner**. Lodging, Friday night dinners, any additional Saturday dinners or Sunday breakfasts will need to be purchased separately at checkout. This fee structure was arranged to accommodate single handed boats such as Lasers. Participants may check in at Apserkaha beginning Thursday, July 26th after 12:00 PM.

A late registration fee of \$30 will be assessed for Santana 20 registrations after July 1, 2018. A late registration fee of \$30 will be assessed for Geary 18 and Southern Cascade Regatta registrations after July 15, 2018 with an additional \$30 late fee assessed to Santana 20's registering after that date. Online registration ends at midnight (end of day) July 23, 2018.

Please note: Friday and Saturday dinner prices increase \$5 and Sunday breakfast prices increase \$2.50 for all meals purchased on site or after July 21st on-line. There will be a limited number of additional meals available to those who have not pre-purchased and once they've been sold, no additional meals will be available.

Packet pick up and on-site registration (cash or check only) for the Santana 20's begins on Thursday July 26th at 08:30 am at the RYC storage shed near the resort marina.

Packet pick-up and on-site registration (cash or check only) for the Geary 18's begins on Friday July 27th at 8:00 am at race headquarters (Apserkaha).

Packet pick-up and on-site registration (cash or check only) for the Southern Cascade Regatta begins on Saturday July 28th at 8:00 am at race headquarters (Apserkaha).

Notice - Aquatic Invasive Species Permit

We have received confirmation from the Oregon State Marine Board that the information given in the past regarding the Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) Permit program for out of state sailboats was correct. All out of state sailboats 12' or longer are considered motor boats for the purpose of the AIS program and therefore require a "motorboat with out of state registration" permit. These annual permits are \$20 and must be on board and available for inspection by law enforcement. The penalty for not having one is \$50.

Additional information not previously provided was that:

Out of state sailboats between 10' and 12' are considered non-motorized and must have an annual \$5 "non-motorized boat" permit. The penalty for not having one is \$30.

One year non-motorized and motorized permits and may be purchased at Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife (ODFW) retailers for \$7 and \$22 respectively (\$2 retailer service charge added).

It's easier to purchase on-line as the retailer must enter your ID into the ODFW database, which is done for on-line purchases anyway. "Non-motorized boat" permits are only available in a 2 year duration on-line for \$10.

Lodging

Lodging is available at Apserkaha in the form of bunk style cabins with sleeping pads (bring your own bedding), tent sites and RV hook ups with water and electric. For cabins, we encourage you to group up with other participants to save money and conserve cabin space. Lodging is first come, first served and available in the following price structures only:

Please understand that it is extremely difficult for us to price lodging using a per person, per day pricing structure. This pricing structure encourages participants to come early and stay late while offering value when compared to other camping options at Howard Prairie Lake.

Southern Cascade Regatta Highlights Santana 20 - Geary 18 Class Events

On Thursday evening July 26th, the Santana 20 Class will be hosting a hamburger BBQ at Apserkaha for their class membership. RYC will not be serving a meal that day, so arriving participants who are not a Santana 20 class member should come prepared with their own meals. RYC will only be serving a Friday and Saturday dinner along with the Sunday breakfast. There is a restaurant available at Howard Prairie Resort Marina for those wishing to utilize that option.

Happy Hour will commence approximately 45 min prior to dinner time on Friday and Saturday.

Dinner on Friday night will run from 6:30 PM to 7:45 PM.

Dinner on Saturday night will run from 6:45 PM to 8:00 PM.

These timeframes allows racers time to tuck their boats away after racing without being rushed.

Sunday breakfast runs from 8:00 to 9:15 AM.

Start time for Sunday's races will be based on wind speed and direction, with an "on-call" system to wait for winds to stabilize. Please review the Sailing Instructions for specific start times regarding skipper's meetings and race events.

Award ceremony to follow at the RYC "Clubhouse" near the Howard Prairie Resort marina. Trophies to be awarded for each class based upon the number of boats registered.

Directions

Regatta Location: Howard Prairie Lake, Ashland, OR.

Take I-5, Exit 14, travel east on Hwy 66 less than one mile to the junction of Dead Indian Memorial Road on left (Sign: Mountain Lakes). Follow Dead Indian Memorial Rd. for 17 miles then turn right on Hyatt Prairie Road. Travel a little over 3 miles to the Howard Prairie Resort entrance, on the left. This will be the launch and moorage location for boats. Check with the marina office for payment and moorage availability. Regatta Headquarters is accessed by turning left after exiting the resort, (or continuing straight if going direct to Apserkaha) and driving 2 miles, taking the first left on Howard Prairie Dam Road. The entrance to Apserkaha Campground is on your left, 100 yards past mile marker #2, which is on the right shoulder. As a reminder, please to keep your speed to 5 mph on Apserkaha grounds to limit road dust. Thank you.
