## NOTICE of RACE

Ventura Yacht Club invites you to join us for the 2018 Commodore Classic Race. As before, this race is designed to promote relaxed fun and good sportsmanship. The race will consist of one coastal race. Complimentary guest docking will be available at VYC before and after the race. Please contact the VYC office about guest docking at the above phone number.

**DATE:** Sunday, June 3, 2018. The warning signal for the race is scheduled for 1155 hours. The start

will be at the Ventura Harbor Whistle Buoy "R2" and the finish will be in the Ventura Harbor

entrance. There is No Entry Fee for this event.

**RULES:** The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), except

as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions. Each entry shall have a Staff or present Rear, Vice, or Commodore (from any yacht club) as the helmsperson. There will be one

PHRF class.

**HANDICAPS:** PHRF Area A random leg base handicaps will be used. While PHRF certificates are not

required, PHRF Corinthian Rating Adjustments will be honored. Boats with cruising gear and not possessing an official PHRF Corinthian Rating Adjustment may request a similar rating adjustment for this race only by submitting a Commodore Classic Rating Adjustment Form showing their cruising inventory (see Sailing Instructions). Boats declaring as Non-Spinnaker can also use their Non-Spinnaker Offset. For boats without a valid handicap, the Race

Committee will provide a temporary handicap for this race.

SAFETY: All boats must conform to USCG and US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (USSER) for a US

Sailing Nearshore Race as modified below. USSERs are available online at ussailing.org (click on

Safety).

USS SER 3.19.1 is modified to allow compasses such as the TACK TICK and Velocitek Shift (non GPS) magnetic compasses with mounted brackets as long as they are tethered so the device may not be lost overboard.

USS SER Rule 3.8.2 is in effect for this race and modified to require a water proof VHF or a VHF with a

water proof cover even if it does not have DSC/GPS capability.

USS SER 3.3.1 is modified to allow running lights that are mounted below deck level. (common on 90's

and earlier boats).

A minimum of 2 crew are required.

**INSURANCE:** Each participating boat shall have valid third-party liability insurance.

**ENTRY:** Competitors are urged to register online anytime prior to the race. Go to

www.venturayachtclub.org and follow the link (Water>Racing>Regatta Network). It's easy! Additional information, including Sailing Instructions are also available there. And, to say thank

you for all your hard work as Commodores, the entry fee is waived for this event.
