### NOTICE OF RACE Dated 17 June 2018

#### Charleston Yacht Club Open Regatta 21 - 22 July 2018

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*;
- 1.2. Appendix V as noted in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3. The USS prescriptions to rules 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all one-design classes with 3 or more boats registered. The E-scow fleet is required to sail with 'float packs' at all times while racing.
- 2.2. Eligible boats shall enter by completing the Entry Form attached to this document and paying appropriate fee. Entry forms will also be available at registration.

#### 3. FEES

- Junior sailors \$20
- Single-handed \$30
- Double-handed (including MC) \$40
- Triple-handed \$50
- Four or more sailors (including E-scows) \$60

- **5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Sailing instructions will be available at registration.
- **6. RACE AREA:** There will be three circles to which classes will be assigned for racing. All circles will be located in Charleston Harbor.

#### 7. SCORING

- 7.1. An unlimited number of races are planned. If six or more races are completed, each boat will have one score excluded.
- 7.2. One race will constitute a series for the regatta.

#### 8. PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1. Sections V1 and V2 of Appendix V will be in effect.

- 9. PRIZES: Prizes will be awarded per class as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place awarded for 3 boats;
  - 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> for 4-6 boats;
  - 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> for 7-9 boats;
  - 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> for 10 or more boats.
  - Trophies for Masters, Senior and Junior classes will be awarded for the Sunfish class based on numbers of boats participating.
  - An overall trophy will be awarded the Optimist class, along with a trophy for each of the Optimist levels.
- 10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. Charleston Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
