2018 Flying Scot New England District Championship Notice of Race

1. **Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the current edition of the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the rules of Flying Scot Sailing Association® http://www.fssa.com/sites/default/files/master_constitution_bylaws_7-23-2018.pdf and the regatta sailing instructions.
2. **Eligibility:** This regatta is open to all members of the Flying Scot Sailing Association – membership applications will be available at the regatta or you may join or renew online at <http://www.fssa.com/join>
3. **Registration:** Registration, including those attending for meals only, may be completed online on Regatta Network at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/17023> or at the regatta site beginning Saturday, August 18, 2018, at 0800. All registrations must be paid by 0930 on Saturday, August 18, 2018.
4. **Measurement:** All boats may be checked for required safety equipment.
5. **Fees:** The fee is \$50 through 8/11/2018 and \$60 after that. The fee includes continental breakfast before racing, a barbecue after racing for skipper and 1 crew. The cost for extra barbecue dinners is \$15 per person.
6. **Schedule:** Five races are scheduled, weather permitting, The schedule of events is as follows:

7. **Courses to be Sailed:** The courses to be sailed are illustrated in the regatta sailing instructions.
8. **Radio Communication:** VHF radios are allowed and the Race Committee will broadcast on Channel 74. The Race Committee will attempt to announce sail numbers of boats that are over early. Failure of the Race Committee to do so will not be grounds for redress.
9. **Trophies:** Trophies will be awarded to the top 5 skippers and crew in the regatta. The New England District Championship and SMSA trophies will be awarded to the top skipper from the New England District.
