Rules: Racing shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing and the class rules of the International Hobie Class Association. Competitors are reminded that per IHCA class rule 26, at least one crew member per boat shall be a paid member of the Hobie Class Association. RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

Eligibility and Entry: This event is open to all class legal Hobie Wave's Hobie 14's, Hobie 16's, Hobie 17's, Hobie 18's, Hobie 20's, Hobie Tiger and Wild Cat; for example, Wave sails must be Hobie-branded.

Fees:

Double handed: \$ 65 Single handed: \$ 55 Youth: free; Youth are defined as all crew under the age of 21 on December 31 of the year the event begins. HCANA membership will be paid for first time skippers.

When more than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

The objective is 3-5 races per day. There is no maximum number of races scheduled.
