- 1. RULES
- 1.1 This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Appendix T, expedited hearings will be in force.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES
- 2.1 All One Design Boats, limited to 5 classes at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- 2.2 We invite the Tartan 101 fleet and the J109 fleet to race as a single fleet for one day.
- 2.3 Entrant must be a member of a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing, and a member of the fleet in which it competes.
- 2.4 The payment of the entry fee can be processed online or mailed to the SCCYC.

Entry Fees are as follows:

Boats 20 feet and under \$30

Boats over 20 feet up to 31 feet \$70

Boats over 31 and over feet \$90

75ers One Day \$45

Discount for Entries before Saturday, July 28th - \$10

Note: Entry fee includes complimentary informal dinner for all racers on both days.

4. SCHEDULE

Saturday, July 28, 2100 hrs. Deadline for Discounted Entry Fee Saturday, August 4th, 0900 hrs: Deadline for entry.

Saturday, August 4th and Sunday August 5th. 1330 hrs (1:30 PM) First warning signal. *Sunset is not till 2000 hours!*, the race committee will attempt to finish racing by 6 PM latest on Saturday, 5 PM on Sunday 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at SCCYC.org and Regatta Network no later than 2000 hours on Saturday July 10st.

6. COURSES

- 6.1 Courses will be primarily windward/leeward using orange and yellow inflatable marks.
- 6.2 The course will be north of the Marina del Rey Spar buoys.
- 6.3 There will be 4 or more races for all classes on Saturday and 3 or more races for all classes on Sunday.
- 6.4 Different classes may sail a different number of races, as requested by class representatives, and as weather allows.

7. PENALTIES

Rule 44 is changed so that if an incident occurs outside the three-boat-length zone for a rounding or finishing mark, then the penalty under rule 44.2 shall be one turn including one tack and one gibe.

8. SERIES SCORING

Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A, with one throw out, if 6 or more races are completed.

9. TROPHIES

Trophies for the Series and the perpetual for the winning Martin 242, will be awarded at SCCYC following the last race on Sunday.

10. HOSPITALITY

Come and enjoy our new temporary Club House in Fisherman's Village. Complimentary informal dinner for all racers as well as a no-host bar will be available at the SCCYC Club House following the racing. Two hour parking will be available. Please note, do not back into the parking space, you will get a ticket.
