Notice of Race

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-2020).
- 1.2. Each participating boat shall comply with respective Class Rules

2. Advertising

2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. Regatta is open to the following classes: X-boat, Optimist, Club 420, Melges 14 and Open Bic. Minimum of 5 boats must register by 6/30/2018 to form a class.
- 3.2. Competitors shall meet age requirements for ILYA X-boat and Optimist Dinghy classes
- 3.3. Melges 14 competitors can choose Red or Blue sail types at the time of registration. No changes of sail will be permitted after registration. For charter boats contact Melges Boat Works
- 3.4. Junior competitors' parents or guardians will be required to sign a waiver of liability at check-in.
- 3.5. All competitors shall wear, while on the water, a properly fastened U.S. Coast Guard approved, Inherently Buoyant Type III PFDs

4. Registration and Fees

- 4.1. All entry fees shall be paid during online registration at www.regattanetwork.com
- 4.2. Entry fees: X-Boat \$120, C420: \$85 Optimist, M14, Open Bic: \$55 If paid by 6/30/2018
- 4.3. A late fee of \$20 shall be paid for registrations completed from 7/1/2018 through 7/7/2018
- 4.4. An additional \$50 late fee (\$70 total) shall be paid after 7/8/2018
- 4.5. Entry Fees are NONREFUNDABLE and may not be transferred to another event

- 10.3. Optimist, Club 420, Melges 14 and Open Bic will be ramp launched; each boat must have a dolly.
