1. <u>Rules:</u>

- 1.1. The race will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) except as changed by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. PHRF of Southern California (PHRF SoCal) "Marine Industry Racer Rule" will not apply.

2. Eligibility:

- 2.1. This race is open to boats with a 2018 PHRF Certificate and ORCA members.
- 2.2. To be eligible for entry, each boat must:
 - (a) be entered by an individual who is a member of US Sailing or other organization affiliated to US Sailing or to SCYA (or their own National Authority); **and**
 - (b) have a valid PHRF SoCal Rating Certificate with an OWC rating; \boldsymbol{or}

(c) for Cruising Classes, have a 2018 PHRF SoCal Corinthian Rating (Cruising Class boats must have a PHRF certificate and apply to PHRF SoCal for a Corinthian rating for which there is no additional fee. Information about joining PHRF SoCal is available at <u>www.phrfsocal.org</u> or at 562.438.6712); **or**

(d) be a member of ORCA and have a valid rating issued by ORCA.

3. Entry:

- 3.1. Eligible boats must enter the race on Regatta Network (regattanetwork.com/event/17167)
- 3.2. Entries must be received by 2000 on Wednesday, August 29th.
- 3.3. The entry fee is \$45.00 or \$40.00 for US Sailing Members.
- 3.4. Late entries <u>may</u> be accepted with Race Chair approval and a \$15.00 late fee after the entry deadline.

4. <u>Classes:</u>

- 4.1. Classes will be established for PHRF, Cruising spinnaker, Cruising non spinnaker and ORCA based on entries received prior to 2000 hours Wednesday, August 29.
- 4.2. A minimum of 4 paid entries will be required to establish a class. Entries that have not met the minimum may be assigned to another appropriate class.
- 4.3. Classes, class flags and the order of starts will be posted on the official notice board outside the main office at Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club and online at http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/17167 or www.smwyc.org no later than 1800 hours on Thursday, August 30.

5. <u>Schedule:</u>

Saturday, September 1, 2018:

- The scheduled time of the 1st Warning Signal is 1125.
- Cut off time for finishing is 1900 hours.
- The trophy presentation will be at Seal Beach Yacht Club followed by a delicious pork roast dinner and a live band.

6. Sailing instructions:

Sailing Instructions will be available at <u>www.smwyc.org</u> or posted at <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/17167</u> no later than 1800 hours on August 31, 2018.

7. The Course:

- From Start Line near H Mark, leaving the El Segundo buoy R"2ES", the PV buoy R"10PV" and Point Fermin buoy "R6" to Port to the finishing line in Alamitos Bay.
- A line connecting the Alamitos Bay Jetty mid-channel buoys is a continuing obstruction not to be crossed and shall be left to port. The handicap distance will be 29.9 Miles

8. <u>Scoring:</u>

- 8.1. For PHRF Classes Off-Wind Course Base (OWC) rating will apply.
- 8.2. For Cruising Spinnaker Classes, the PHRF So Cal Corinthian Rating will apply.
- 8.3. For Cruising Non-Spinnaker Classes, the PHRF So Cal Corinthian Rating will apply with the non-spinnaker offset.
- 8.4. For ORCA classes, the ORCA rating will apply.

9. Radio Communication:

While on the water, the RC may communicate with competing boats via VHF radio, including starting penalties.

10.<u>Awards:</u>

- 10.1. Trophies will be awarded in each class.
- 10.2. An overall winner in PHRF Racing Classes (not Cruising) will be awarded the perpetual "Down the Coast" trophy for the best overall corrected time. This is the first time this trophy will be awarded.
- 10.3. **RUM** will be awarded for the best Pirate Costume and Pirate Boat.

11.<u>Docking:</u>

Entrants requiring slips shall make their own arrangements as follows:

• In Marina del Rey:

Slips are available at Burton Chase Park on a first come, first serve basis. Park your boat and walk up to the office. You will need your documentation/registration and an ID. The cost is \$1.15 per ft/per night

• In Long Beach:

Skippers wishing a free slip should contact Joe at at <u>mailto:joenegron3@gmail.com</u> or 949-285-7251. If anyone wants to stay longer than one night, You can call the city <u>562-570-3215</u>, or email alamitosbaymarina@longbeach.gov. You will need documentation/registration and proof of insurance. The cost is \$1.25 per ft/per night.
