NOTICE OF RACE

This Wianno Senior Regatta organizing authority is the Stone Horse Yacht Club.

- 1. Rules** -The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS).For the purposes of the definition of rule, the class rules shall be the rules of the Wianno Senior class. Rules may be changed and these changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions, or as amendments to the Sailing Instructions (See Section 5 of this Notice)
- 2. Eligibility and Entry** -This regatta is open to all Wianno Seniors. Competitors may register online via the Stone Horse Yacht Club/Regatta Network website. Competitors may also register at Check-in/Arrival on July 28, 2018 at the Stone Horse Yacht Club

- 4. Liability**- Each Skipper accepts full responsibility and liability. Neither the Stone Horse Yacht Club nor its Governors, Officers, Employees, Race Committee, members or any other individual or entity affiliated with this regatta shall be held responsible to any participating boat owner, skipper, crew, or their families, heirs or assigns. See RRS 4 Decision to Race.
- 5. Sailing Instructions**-Sailing instructions will be available at the Wianno Senior website, SHYC Regatta Network website, and at the SHYC Clubhouse on Saturday, July 28. Any amendments to the sailing instructions will be posted on the notice board in the SHYC clubhouse prior to the 1130 on July 28, 2018.
- 6. Race area and Courses**-Race area will be ½ mile southwest of the Wychmere harbor breakwater. Courses will be delineated in the Sailing Instructions.
- 7. Scoring**-Scoring is determined by the “Cox-Sprague” scoring system with no drops.
- 8. Support Boats** - All support boats must stay clear of the race course at all times, and must follow any instructions of the Race Committee or designated patrol boats.
- 9. Logistics**
 - Sailing to Harwich Port:** Wychmere Harbor is approximately 18 nautical miles from Osterville. In a fair breeze of 6-7 knots of wind it can take 3 hours.
 - There are two harbors at Wychmere**, the outer harbor and the inner harbor. Seniors will be moored in both the outer and inner harbors. The perimeters of the harbor and channel can be very shallow at low tide. *See Nautical Chart below.*
 - Wychmere channel:** note that the entrance to the inner harbor has narrowed considerably.
 - Arrival**—when you are just beyond the Kill Pond buoy ~~Page 11~~ contact Stone Horse Yacht Club on VHF channel 73 to receive further instructions and assistance. If arriving after hours, call **Lucy Steere (508-776-7491)**

- **Launch Service** will be provided by young volunteers from Stone Horse Yacht Club. These volunteers can show you to your mooring, take you ashore and tow you in and out of the harbor if requested.
- **Cocktail Party** will be held at the Steere boathouse, located on Wychmere Harbor, 59 Snow Inn Road. Wianno Senior skippers, crew, spouses and race committee are invited. There is NO parking for guests at the boathouse. All guests must park on Freeman Street or Bay View Lane and walk-in. *See street map below.*
