NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Rule 40 is changed as follows: All competitors are required to wear a life jacket or other adequate personal floatation while racing.
- 1.3 Appendix V1, Penalty at the Time of an Incident, will be in effect.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Any person in 110 District III is eligible.
- 2.2 An entry fee of \$30 will be charged to cover expenses.

3.0 SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Competitors are strongly encouraged to launch on Friday and wet sail their boats through the weekend.
- 3.2 Racing will be held on Saturday, July 14th, and Sunday, July 15th
- 3.3 Registration will start in the picnic area at 9:30 am on Saturday, July 14th
- 3.4 A skipper's meeting will be held at 11:00 AM on Saturday, July 14th
- 3.5 Depending on the wind and tide, the Warning signal for the first race on Saturday will be at 12:30 PM and on Sunday at 1:00 PM.
- 3.6 There will be a trophy presentation following the conclusion of racing on Sunday. No races shall be started after 4:00 PM on Sunday.

4.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration on Saturday, July 14th. An unofficial copy may be emailed prior to that date.

5.0 RACING AREA

The intended racing area will be approximately one mile northwest of the IYC pier.

6.0 SCORING

- 6.1 Two completed races will constitute a series.
- 6.2 Five races are scheduled, three for Saturday, and two on Sunday.
- 6.3 If fewer than five races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. If five races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score, except that a DSQ cannot be excluded. If five races are completed and a boat has a DSQ, then the next worse score will be excluded.

7.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors shall participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see Rule 4, DECISION TO RACE). The organizing authority does not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
