NOTICE OF RACE**

Host: Pleasant Bay Community Boating & Chatham YC**

Saturday, August 4, 2018 – Sunday August 5, 2018

1. RULES.

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in current *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

2. SAFETY

All competitors must wear properly fastened USCG approved Type III non-inflatable lifejacket at all times while on the water, except to quickly change clothing.

3. ELIGIBILITY.

- 3.1 A crew consists of three people total (Helm and two crew). All competitors must have reached their 19th birthday during the calendar year.
- 3.2 All competitors must be members in good standing of the same club or sailing organization that is a member of Southern Mass Sailing Association (SMSA).
- 3.3 One entry per SMSA Club. The SM Sailing Administrator may waive this rule at his discretion if registration totals is not meet.

4. ENTRY.

- 4.1 Regatta registration fee is zero (\$0.00).
- 4.2 All contestants must pay a \$500 refundable damage deposit in order to compete.
- 4.2 All Registration must be done and fees paid on-line at Regatta Networks
- 4.3 Registration opens July 13th. Registration closes at 1600 on Thursday August 2nd.
- 4.4 There is a minimum of 4 boats and a maximum of 8 boats on a first come, first serve basis.

5. BOATS. Boats are Flying Scots with spinnaker provided by PBCB. Boats will be assigned by PBCB as clubs register.

7. FORMAT: Three races will constitute a series. Number of races is at the discretion of the race committee.
