

Hog Island Race

Saturday, September 1, 2018

Sailing Instructions

Competitors Meeting - 1:00 pm

First Warning - 2:00 pm

Number of Starts - One; all classes will start together.

Start/Finish - Between two orange balls set to the east of the pier.

Rounding Marks - Channel markers to the west of Hog Island, #7 (green) and lateral marker north of it (green and red).

Restricted Mark - Buoy "10" at Pelican Point must be left to the west.

Course - Start - #7 and lateral marker both to be left on the same side, either port or starboard
- Finish

Shorten Course - The course may be shortened at any time after the start. If it is, an orange pyramid buoy will be placed approximately half way between the eastern and western shores of the bay and a patrol boat will stand by displaying the "S" flag (shorten course) and giving repeated sound signals. This buoy will not be placed unless the course is shortened. If the course is shortened, this buoy will replace the rounding marks identified above.

Addendum (August 29, 2018)

Time Limit: The time limit is 3.25 hours from the start or 5:30 pm, whichever is earlier. If no boats finish by the time limit, the race will be abandoned. Boats not finishing within 45 minutes of the first boat that finishes within the time limit will be scored DNF.
