SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **RULES:** The race will be governed by the current 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) except as modified by the Notice of Race and/or the Sailing Instructions.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the door of the RBYC Race Committee Room.
- 2.2 Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted by 1100, day of Race.
- 2.3 The Race Committee may provide VHF radio broadcasts on VHF channel 78.
- 2.4 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the club flagstaff located 10 yards west of the clubhouse entrance.

3. RACE SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Each class will have one race.
- 3.2 **Class Splits are PHRF Buoy ratings: A: <=66, B: 67-137, C: 138-275,**
- 3.3 The starting times and order for the classes is intended to be:

1254 - multiple horns, one minute prep.

1255- Class B-warning,

1300- Class B Start

1305- Class C Start

1310- Class A Start

4. COURSES AND MARKS

- 4.1 The courses will use the marks in front of Redondo Beach shown on the mark guide found online at www.khyc.org **“S” Mark is at: 33° 50’ 51.5” - 118° 24’ 44.3”**
- 4.2 The race committee will designate the course to be sailed by displaying the corresponding course number no later than the Preparatory Signal. This changes RRS 27.1.
- 4.3 The courses are shown on a list of courses at the end of these instructions.
- 4.4 Round all marks to port.

5. THE START

- 5.1 The starting line will be between an Orange Flag on the RC boat and an Orange Flag on a pin floating to Port of the RC boat.
- 5.2 The starting line is restricted unless starting.
- 5.3 The starts of the races will be conducted according to RRS 26.
- 5.4 All competing vessels must check in with the committee boat prior to 1155.
- 5.5 Boats not in their starting sequence please avoid boats that are starting.
- 5.6 The Race Committee may hail OCS boats on channel 78. Failure of the Race Committee to hail, or a boat to hear its hail, or the order of the hails, is not grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

6. THE FINISH

- 6.1 The Finish Line is between an orange flag on the race committee boat and the Red Nun Buoy located at the harbor entrance. "W" (white channel buoy) is a mark of the course.
- 6.2 The Finish Line is restricted, unless finishing.

7. PENALTY The first two sentences of RRS 44.1 are modified to: A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 while racing.

8. TIME LIMIT A boat failing to finish by 1700 will be scored "DNF" by the Race Committee. This changes RRS 35 and A4.1.

9. PROTESTS

- 9.1 Boats intending to protest must fly a red flag upon finishing and notify the Race Committee boat while on station.
- 9.2 Protests shall be written on forms available at the club and delivered to the Race Chairman or PRO within 45 minutes after the race committee boat docks.

10. SCORING

- 10.1 RLC ratings, time on time (TOT), using the low point system.

11. SAFETY

- 11.1 A boat that retires must notify the Race Committee as soon as possible, on vhf Ch-78, or 310-806-2992.

12. Disclaimer of Liability – Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material Damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the race.
