A one-day regatta for the novice 420 racer

NOTICE OF RACE

This invitational regatta is designed for 420 skippers and crews of all ability levels who are able to navigate a basic race course in a timely manner. The intention of the regatta is introduce new 420 sailors to the racing community, as such, coaching will be allowed for the back half of the fleet.

1. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of *US Sailing*, *420 Class Rules* and any amendments to the former noted in the *Sailing Instructions*

2. Eligibility & Entry

The Club 420 Fleet and all sailors who will have not reached their 19th birthday during the calendar year. We highly encourage sailors who have NOT yet placed in the top 20 of an SM Sailing regatta.

3. Registration

Registration can be completed online via the Regatta Network or on the day of the regatta at the registration desk. The registration forms for skippers and crew, are posted on

All sailors must submit a completed registration package (skipper and crew registration forms and medical forms completed and signed) prior to 9:30 AM in order to be eligible to race.

The entry fee is \$50 per sailor – or \$100/boat.

Breakfast will be available at registration; lunch will be provided on the water or on land depending on weather conditions on the day of the regatta.

4. Schedule of Events

Check-in: 0800 – 0900

Skippers Meeting: 0900

Harbor Start: 0930

Lunch: On shore following racing

Awards: *As soon as possible after the conclusion of racing. No races will be started after 1500 unless conditions require a change to these instructions.*

5. Scoring

The Low Point Scoring System will apply. As many races as practical will be run during this regatta. A boat's series score will exclude her worst race only if five or more races are competed. One race constitutes a series.

6. Arrival and Miscellaneous Notes

Early arrivals are more than welcome. Please contact the WHYC program director to arrange a drop-off time.

Sailors should bring a re-usable water bottle. Re-fill stations will be available on shore.
