



Totally Dinghy Regatta Notice of Race

September 22 and 23, 2018
Richmond Yacht Club, Richmond, California

- 1 Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 2 Eligibility and Entry: The regatta is open to all centerboard monohull dinghies. Fleets of 5 or more will have separate starts. All open classes scoring will be based on the Portsmouth handicap system. Eligible boats may enter online at www.richmondyc.org. Entry fee will be \$45 for single-handed boats and \$55 for all others. You must register online by Wednesday Sept.19, at 19:59 PDT to avoid a \$15 late fee. No refunds will be made if late fee applies. Registration closes on Friday Sept. 21 at 12:00 PDT. Light refreshments after Saturday racing is included in the entry fee.

No races shall be started after 15:00 pm PDT
- 4 The Courses: The course areas to be sailed are Potrero Reach, Keller Cove and Southampton Shoals.
- 5 Sailing Instructions: The Sailing Instructions will be available online after 18:00 PDT on Friday, Sept.21 at www.richmondyc.org
- 6 Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 7 Social and Trophies: Drink tickets (one per single-handed and 2 for double-handed will be passed out) and a taco bar will be available on the upper deck after racing on Saturday. There will be a trophy presentation on Saturday for the El Toro fleet and for all other fleets on Sunday after racing.
