NOTICE OF RACE

Rev. 3: 8/23/2018

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board "HYC Race Information" located in the breezeway adjacent to the HYC Office.
- 1.3 RRS 44.1 will be changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

- 2.1 All one-design classes are welcome.
- 2.2 Yachts of similar PHRF ratings (either spin on non-spin) may form a Level Rating Class (LRC).
 - (a) Yachts racing LRC must have a current PHRF Galveston Bay rating certificate.
 - (b) Boats must agree to class rules.
- 2.3 A minimum of three yachts of the same design will constitute a class.
- 2.4 A class of fewer than the required number of entries will be regarded as having failed to form; entry fees will be refunded.
- 2.5 Potential fleets include A-Cat, C-22, Ensign, J/22, J/24, J/70, J/80, J/105, J/109, VX, EVO, Lightning, Viper, Melges 24, F18, VX One, Pulse 600, Etchells, RS Aero, Sonar and Level 70. In addition, any other one-design class with 3 or more entrants will constitute a separate class. Potential classes not listed or trying to form should contact the Event Chair, Beth Gibson at sailingmom25@yahoo.com.
- 2.6 Boats may enter at www.regattanetwork.com or at the Houston Yacht Club website (www.houstonyachtclub.com) using the on-line entry form. All registrations must be made on-line. NO WALK IN ENTRIES will be allowed.

3. FEES

3.1	Multiple Crew Entry Fee:	\$80

4. SCHEDULE & EVENTS

- 4.1 **Friday, Sept. 14, 2018:** Visiting boats may relocate to HYC, no storage fees
- 4.2 Wednesday, Sept. 19, 2018, 6:00 PM: Entry deadline.
- 4.3 **Thursday, Sept. 20, 2018, 7:00 PM:** Late registration deadline.

4.4 Friday September 21, 2018:

5:00 PM - 7:00 PM: Competitor **Check In**. All boats must check in with the Race Committee.

7:15 PM: Competitor's briefing in the Ballroom.

4.5 Saturday September 22, 2018:

- 9:00 AM: Competitors' briefing for the Dinghy Line at the Beachcomber.
- 11:00 AM: Warning signal for race 1; up to two races to follow.
- Saturday Afternoon: "Decompression" Post racing cold beer, music and war stories in porthole.
- Saturday Early Evening: Mount Gay Cocktail Party featuring complementary Mount Gay rum drinks.
- Saturday Evening: The official **Regatta Banquet and musical entertainment**. Dinner tickets will be available for purchase at Check In.

4.6 **Sunday September 23, 2018:**

- 10:30 AM. Warning signal for first race of the day, up to 2 additional races to follow.
- No warning signal after 2:00 PM.
- Awards presentation time TBA post racing.

5. MEASUREMENT

5.1 Yachts racing one design will comply with all requirements of the relevant class association.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be distributed at the Competitor's Briefing. Thereafter, copies will be available at the HYC Club Office.

7. VENUE

- 7.1 All races will be sailed in the vicinity of the Houston Yacht Club in that part of Galveston Bay bounded by Morgan's Point on the North, the Bayport Ship Channel on the South, the Houston Ship Channel on the East, and the La Porte/Shore Acres shoreline on the West.
- 7.2 There will be up to three races courses. A dinghy course for dinghy classes and other keel boats of similar size, a large keelboat course for other similar sized classes and there may be a course located south of the Bayport Channel depending on entries.

8. THE COURSES

8.1 All classes will race a windward – leeward course around floating marks.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 A single completed race will constitute a series.
- 9.2 The low-point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply. No scores will be excluded. This modifies RRS Appendix A.
- 9.3 A total of 6 races are planned.

10. BERTHING

- 10.1 Racers are invited to leave their boats at HYC for the week before and week after the regatta at no charge. HOWEVER, upon arrival all boat owners must complete a registration form available at the front desk and include an emergency contact number.
- Hotel rooms are available in the clubhouse with a reservation. Please check with the club staff for availability and rates for these budget accommodations..
- 10.3 For local accommodations in La Porte, please click on the "Sail In to La Porte" link which is located at the bottom of the HYC Race Schedule Page.

11. PRIZES

11.1 Trophies will be awarded based on the number of registrants.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
