



NOTICE OF RACE CCYC Race Week

w/ Surfin Safari II (J/22 SouthWest Circuit Stop #5)
Aug 22-26, 2018



(Preface: The first part of this document pertains to PHRF fleets (All Sails and 150 Class boats). J/22 Southwest Circuit participants please proceed to “Addendum to Notice of Race – Surfin’ Safari II (2018 J/22 Southwest Circuit Regatta #5)”)

1. INVITATION

- 1.1. You are cordially invited to participate in and attend the 2018 Corpus Christi Yacht Club Race Week.
- 1.2. The regatta is open to any yacht that holds a valid South Texas PHRF Certificate. If a yacht does not have a rating certificate, the Race Committee reserves the right to assign a rating for the purpose of this regatta.
- 1.3. This regatta is also open to all J/22 One Design Sailboats. J/22s will sail under the “Addendum to Notice of Race – Surfin’ Safari II (2018 J/22 Southwest Circuit Regatta #5)” and the appropriate Sailing Instructions. J22s are invited to participate in both the Wednesday night races and the Friday night 420 races, but they will not be counted towards CCYC Race Week.

2. RULES

- 2.1. The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the associated prescriptions of the U.S. Sailing Association, this Notice, and the official Sailing Instructions for the regatta.
- 2.2. Where there is any conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall control.

3. REGISTRATION

- 3.1. All boats may register for this regatta at:

- 3.2. Registration Fee – PHRF Boats ONLY
 - 3.2.1. The registration fee for PHRF racing on Wednesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday is \$80.00 for each boat. Registration ends on August 21, 2018 at 1900 hrs.
 - 3.2.2. This registration fee includes the entry for one boat in the 420 Races.
 - 3.2.3. The registration fee also includes food and beverage for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
 - 3.2.4. The late registration fee for PHRF racing is \$10.00 (total of \$90.00) for each boat. Late registration starts August 21, 2018 at 1901 hrs.
- 3.3. Registration Fee – 420’s ONLY
 - 3.3.1. The registration fee for the 420 races is \$30.00 for each boat. Registration ends on August 24, 2016 at 1700 hrs. All entries are encouraged to register online.
 - 3.3.2. The registration fee includes the entry for one centerboard boat; the fee covers a crew of two for one centerboard boat such as a 420. The fee also includes food for Friday.
 - 3.3.3. The registration fee includes use of one of CCYC’s Club 420s.

- 3.3.4. Only one (1) team per PHRF boat and you must declare which PHRF boat you are representing at the skippers meeting.
- 3.3.5. You do not have to represent a PHRF boat to participate.
- 3.3.6. In order for the results to count towards a PHRF boat's Race Week scores, both participants must sail a minimum of 3 other Race Week races on the boat they are representing. See more information under Section 7. Scoring

4. REGATTA SCHEDULE

4.1. Tuesday, August 21, 2018

1900hrs.: Skipper's Meeting for keelboat races to be held on the upstairs deck of the CCYC, Sailing Instructions will be distributed

4.2. Wednesday, August 22, 2018

1800hrs.: Wednesday night course will be used. Standard Wednesday night start times.
Social: Post-race beverages and snacks.

4.3. Friday, August 24, 2018 – Centerboard Races ONLY

1730hrs.: Skipper's Meeting for centerboard races to be held in the Sailing Center of the CCYC on the first floor near the pool, Sailing Instructions for centerboard races will be available at the meeting.

1815hrs.: First signal of centerboard races

Social: Beverages and snacks will be available after the races.

4.4. Saturday, August 25, 2018

0930hrs.: Skipper's Meeting

1030hrs.: First signal for PHRF & J/22 races

Post-race Social and Drinks on the CCYC Upper Deck.

4.5. Sunday August 26, 2018

09:30hrs.: First signal for PHRF & J/22 races

12:00hrs.: No races to be started after.

Post-race beer and snacks. Four warning signals will indicate a twenty-minute warning for trophy presentation to be located on the CCYC upper deck

5. CLASSIFICATION

5.1. PHRF boats

5.1.1. Races for PHRF boats will only be conducted on Wednesday, Saturday, and Sunday.

5.1.2. Wednesday will consist of one race using the normally scheduled Wednesday night races.

5.1.3. Saturday and Sunday racing will consist of multiple windward/leeward races each day.

5.1.4. PHRF boats may be divided into the following classes and starts based on participation:
PHRF A-All Sails, PHRF B-All Sails, PHRF A 150, PHRF B 150, Large Multihulls

5.1.5. For the formation of a class in this regatta, a minimum of three (3) vessels will be required.

5.1.6. The Race Chairman may combine or eliminate classes based on participation.

5.2. 420 Races

5.2.1. Races for centerboard boats will only be conducted on Friday.

5.2.2. On Friday, teams will be assigned to CCYC 420s, and race in multiple races inside the marina.

5.2.3. Awards will be given to the top three teams.

5.3. J/22 One Design

5.3.1. Races for J/22's will only be conducted on Saturday and Sunday.

5.3.2. J/22 Races are invited to participate in 420 Races and will be eligible for awards for 420 races, but their results will not count towards the circuit/regatta results in any way

5.3.3. For all things related to the J/22 fleet, the “Addendum to Notice of Race – Surfin’ Safari (2018 J/22 Southwest Circuit Regatta #5)” shall control.

6. LIABILITY

6.1. Registering for and entering the Regatta shall in no way hold Corpus Christi Yacht Club, its officers, committee persons, and/or any sponsoring group liable for injury to participants, crew, or yachts.

7. SCORING

7.1. Appendix A, Low Point Scoring system will apply.

7.2. 1 score will be excluded once 6 races have been run for the PHRF fleet. This changes Appendix A2.1. No scores will be excluded for the J/22 fleet.

7.3. The 420 Races will count as a single race in PHRF Race Week scores.

7.3.1. If there are more participants than boats available, two or more “heats” will be formed.

The top boats from each of the “heats” will proceed to a championship round. Since only the boats in the championship round can be properly scored those participants will be scored the number of points according to where they place. Other participants will be scored a Number-of-boats-in-Championship-round +1. Ex. If there are 4 boats that compete in the championship round they will receive a 1, 2, 3, and 4 respectively whereas all other participants in the 420 races will be given a 5.

7.3.2. Any boats that do not participate in the 420 races, but are entered in race week, will be scored number of entries +1.

7.3.3. The results of the 420 races are eligible to be a throwout.

7.3.4. Each PHRF boat must designate two (2) crew members prior to the start of the 420 races for representing them in the 420 races.

7.3.4.1. Designated crew members from different PHRF boats cannot sail on the same 420 if they wish to represent a PHRF boat.

7.3.4.2. All designated crew members must race in at least three (3) other races during race week with the same PHRF boat they are representing.

7.4. The Mayor’s Cup will be awarded to the overall winner of the All Sails fleets sailing in Race Week.

8. Trophies

Trophies will be awarded for the top three (3) finishers in each fleet.

9. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

9.1. All Piers, L-Head and T-Heads are considered Public Parks and are run and patrolled by the City of Corpus Christi. No open containers are allowed in the city's Public Parks.

9.2. Please note that pets are not allowed on club (CCYC) property.

Addendum to Notice of Race - Surfin' Safari II (2018 J/22 Southwest Circuit Regatta #5) August 25 & August 26, 2018 Corpus Christi Yacht Club



Corpus Christi Yacht Club and J/22 Fleet cordially invite you to participate in the US J/22 Class Association (USJ22CA) District 5, 2018 J/22 Southwest Circuit Regatta #5 to be held from, August 25, 2018 through August 26, 2018. This is a five (5) race Regatta with the option for a sixth race for J/22 Sailboats.

1 Rules

1.1 This series of Regattas will be governed by the 2017 - 2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), International J22 Class Association Rules (IJ22CA), this *Notice of Race* and the *Sailing Instructions*.

1.2 RRS Rule 87 will be changed to read as follows: *The sailing instructions may change a class rule.*

1.3 The same crew and same three class sails must be used during the entire Regatta. Substitutions can only be made with the written approval of the Principal Race Officer or Chief Judge.

1.4 Class Rules 2.8 (eligibility, aka class membership), 2.9 (measurement certificate) and 8.9 (weight limit) of the IJ22CA Class Rules will not apply for eligibility to participate in this Regatta.

Note: Basically, this means that the class membership requirement, boat measurement requirement and the crew weight limitation **do not apply** for eligibility to participate in this Circuit Regatta and will not affect scoring nor prizes/awards in this Regatta. However, Boats lacking a measurement certificate or whose helmsperson does not meet the class membership requirement will suffer a scoring penalty for the 2018 J/22 Southwest Circuit, see *Notice of Circuit* on the J/22 Southwest District website www.j22southwest.org

2 Eligibility and Entry

J/22 Class yachts in compliance with the Class Rules, save and except, those rules excluded in this Notice of Race will be eligible and scored for this event.

3 Location

This Regatta will be held on western Corpus Christi Bay at Corpus Christi Yacht Club, Corpus Christi, TX.

4. Fees

4.1. The entry fee is \$95.00 and \$85.00 with pre-registration. To be eligible for pre-registration, a completed registration form must be completed online by August 22, 2018 at 2359 CDT (11:59:59pm) Online registration is available on the event website (www.regattanetwork.com/event/17488). All registration fees are payable at registration prior to August 25, 2018 at 0900 CDT (9:00am).

4.2. The Registration Fee includes participation in the regatta, use of mast hoists for mast stepping, use of motorized hoist (ramps are also available) to launch and retrieve boats, trailer storage/boat dockage for the duration of the regatta, food and beer after the races on Saturday as part of the traditional informal post race party and snacks and beverage as part of Sunday's award presentation.

This registration fee includes the entry for one boat in the 420 Races (Friday evening)(optional/just for fun-not scored as part of the regatta).

4.3. The registration fees do NOT include access to dock keys needed to open gates to the piers in the Marina. Any boat wanting a gate key to the piers on the L-head must visit the Corpus Christi Marina Office and provide a deposit.

4.4. The Registration Fee does NOT include trailer storage or slip fees prior to the Friday of the regatta or after the Sunday of the regatta. Those arrangements must be made with the Corpus Christi Marina Office.

5 Scoring

Five races are scheduled, of which, two shall be completed to constitute a Regatta. RRS Appendix A4, Low Point Scoring System, will be used to score finishers. No races will be discarded this changes Appendix A2.

6 Trophies

Trophies will be awarded for the top three (3) finishers.

7 Inspection & Measurement

All participants are subject to inspection and measurement at any time during the Regatta. The Race Committee may, at its discretion, inspect any yacht in order to confirm compliance with the prescribed class rules concerning construction and measurements, safety rules when racing, crew prohibition and restrictions when racing. Class royalty tags must be present on all sails.

9 Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available after August 24, 2018 on the event website, www.regattanetwork.com/event/17488. Sailing Instructions shall be provided online but at the election of Race officials may be provided at Registration or the Skipper's Meeting. It is the competitor's obligation to download and print the Sailing Instructions.

10 Courses

Racing will take place on Windward/Leeward courses. Offset weather marks and leeward gates will be used.

11 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in this individual Circuit Regatta and the 2018 J/22 Southwest Circuit entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, *Decision to Race*. The Organizing Authority, Hosts, IJ22CA, District 5 and its officers will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after a Regatta.

12 Bow Numbers

To facilitate scoring and the identification of boats for the purpose of RRS 29.1, 29.2, 30.1, 30.2, 30.3 and 30.4, unique TWO (2) digit bow numbers are required to be fixed to both external port and starboard sides of the forward bow area of each competing boat hull. These numbers must be affixed to both port and starboard as follows:

- a. The leading edge of the forward number shall be 250mm/10" aft of the stem.
- b. The leading edge of the aft numbers shall be 100mm/4" aft of the aft edge of the forward number.
- c. The top edge of both numbers shall be 100mm/4" from the rail.
- d. All numbers must contrast with the color of the hull and be at least 305mm/12" in height.

Bow numbers will be assigned to each participating crew for the duration of the 2018 J/22 Southwest Circuit. Bow numbers 01 through 10 are pre-assigned respectively to the top ten competitors of the 2017 J/22 Southwest Circuit.

Bow numbers 11 through 99 will be assigned out of the then open pool of unassigned numbers by the District Governor for new Circuit participants. Issues relating to bow numbers (e.g. assignment, placement, size, etc.) will be resolved solely by the USJ22CA District 5 Governor of record.

It shall be the responsibility of each participating competitor to obtain and affix the assigned bow numbers to their yacht. The Fleets, host Yacht Clubs and the Southwest District are not responsible to provide numerals for bow numbers.

13. LAUNCHING/RETRIEVING BOATS

A fixed motorized crane will be available for boat launching during registration/check-in times (see Regatta Schedule), to arrange for crane access outside these times contact Doug Weakly at doug.weakly@yahoo.com or Josh Richline at jrichline@Richline.cc. Note that a fixed mast stepping crane

is available. Regatta participants will be responsible for setting up, launching and retrieving their own boats.
