RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). US Sailing Prescriptions shall apply. RRS Appendix V shall apply.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The Coco Seemann Regatta is open to all women sailors. The regatta will be sailed in J/22's with 3 or 4 women teams. There will be no crew weight restrictions. Register here: <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/17535</u>

SCHEDULE

Sunday, September 30, 2018 0900-1000 - Registration - SYC 1015 - Skippers' meeting 1125 – Scheduled warning signal for first race. Additional races to follow. Three races are scheduled. Trophy presentation at the conclusion of racing

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions (SI) will be the SYC General Sailing Instructions available online. SI's will also be available at the registration desk at the Southern Yacht Club.

VENUE

Racing will be on Lake Pontchartrain approximately 1 to 2 miles northly of Southern Yacht Club.

THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward leeward courses.

SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4 of the Racing Rules will apply. One race constitutes a series. No throw-outs, this changes RRS A2.

RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

PRIZES

Trophies will be presented to the top three finishing skippers and crew. The Coco Seemann Trophy will be awarded to the winning skipper and crew.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
