

Sunday, October 7, 14, 21, 28 and November 4th 2018 Amended NOTICE OF RACE

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY: The organizing authority for this series of races is Shoreline Yacht Club

1.0 RULES:

- 1.1 This race shall be governed by the current 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as modified by the Notice of Race and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 Keep clear of all non-racers and Deep Keel commercial traffic.
- 2.0 ENTRY: Sailboats of LOA >= 19' are invited. Competitors may register in advance by completing the Event Registration Form online at Regatta Network (<u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/17596</u>). The deadline for registration is 1800, the Saturday before each race.
- **2.1 Entry Fee** is \$60.00 for the series of five Races or \$15.00 per race.

3.0 CLASSES: Classes will be established based on entries. Minimum of three (3) yachts are required to establish a One Design class. All Classes are Non-Spinnaker.

- **3.1 STARTING LINE:** Will be in the vicinity of buoy 39. First Start is 1300 and it will be a rolling five minute start.
- **3.2 FINISH LINE:** For all races the port end of the finishing line will be the green light at the east end of the detached breakwater near the entrance to Shoreline Marina. The starboard end of the finish line will be the red light on the small mole on Island Grissom. This alters Rule 16.1 in the Sailing Instructions.

4.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The sailing instructions are attached to the Shoreline Yacht Club Chart 16A available on Regatta Network.

5.0 SCORING: Handicap classes will use PHRF or Corinthian local ratings with spinnaker offsets, time on distance. Corinthian classes will be combined with Standard PHRF classes.

- 5.1 All-race scores will count. There will be one throw out
- 5.2 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

6.0 HOSPITALITY: The club is open each race day for brunch starting at 900.

6.1 PARKING: Racers needing temporary parking passes and gate access should contact the front desk of SYC:

6.2 SLIPS: For <u>Temporary dock space</u> use the end of X dock or use the long dock near Tom Parkers Lighthouse Restaurant and close to rainbow harbor.

7.0 PRIZES: There will be post race awards ceremony at Shoreline Yacht Club at 1600 each race day. A perpetual will be awarded to the <u>SYC club member</u> who is the winner of the series. First place trophies will be awarded after each race. Overall trophies are based on entries.

8.0. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk.
