1. **Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined by the current edition of the *Racing Rules Of Sailing (RRS)*.
2. **Eligibility:** This regatta is open to all members of the Flying Scot Class. Current membership in the Flying Scot Sailing Association (FSSA) is required for all skippers.
3. **Registration:** May be by mail using the Registration Form at www.regattanetwork.com/event/17698, may be completed online, or may be completed at the regatta site beginning July 26 at 6:00 PM. Sailing Instructions and Notice of Race will be available to registrants at the completion of registration. Two divisions will be scored, NY Lakes and Overall.
4. **Fees:** See Registration Form.
5. **Schedule:** All events will take place at Skaneateles Sailing Club, 2745 East Lake Road, Skaneateles, NY 13152 (SSC).

6. **Measurement:** Boats and sails must conform to the Official Plan. Each boat must carry equipment required by FSSA Specification Article S-V.2 (Racing Restrictions).

7. **Courses to be Sailed:** The courses to be sailed will be described and illustrated in Appendix A of the Sailing Instructions

8. **Launching and Berthing:** Boats will be launched by tractor. Cars will not be allowed in the launch area. Boats will be assigned a dry sail parking spot and will be dry sailed.

9. **VHF Radios:** It is the intention of the Race Committee to utilize VHF communication in accordance with FSSA Specification S-V-7. The Race Committee will use VHF radio to alert competitors of safety information (such as approaching weather) and hail boats that are on the course side of the starting line (OCS) at the start.

10. **Scoring:** The low point system of RRS Appendix A2 will be used, except that there will be no throw outs. Five (5) races are scheduled, of which one (1) must be completed to constitute a series.

11. **Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded to the top three (3) boats in the District Division and top three (3) boats in the Open Division.
