1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 Edition (RRS).

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

The regatta is open to one-design keelboats and keelboats with a current LNKC PHRF Rating Certificate. (If the boat has not been rated, submit pertinent information to the Lake Norman Keelboat Council at <http://www.lnkc.com> to have a provisional rating assigned. No rating will be changed after completing registration.)

Boats shall be broken into classes as determined by the race committee, based upon registration. One Design Classes shall consist of not less than three like boats. The number and makeup of the PHRF classes will be determined based upon registration.

3. REGISTRATION FEES

Registration and Payment must be received by 11/04 to avoid late fees.

Fees:

- \$45 per keelboat. Late fee \$15 after 11/04
- \$15 Saturday Adult Dinner; Limited dinners will be available for purchase at the event.

All fees and meals should be ordered on-line.

4. SCHEDULE

Racing will be Saturday and Sunday only. A maximum of seven races shall be sailed. No races will be started after 1500 on Sunday.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board located at the Race Management Center. Copies will be available at registration.

6. THE COURSES

Courses planned are around the buoys courses for all classes.

7. SCORING

Scoring will be Low Point Scoring System Appendix A except that all races shall be scored (changes appendix A2). PHRF classes will be scored using Time on Time. A minimum of one race constitutes a Regatta for all fleets.

8. AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded based on number of boats registered by November 4, 2018:

Boats wishing to stay at LNYC until the Keelboat Mid-winters (March 2019) must complete the LNYC Boat Storage Waiver prior to leaving LNYC. The waiver will be provided at Registration.
