## Racing & Rules

Up to five races are scheduled with one throw-out for five races. Racing will be governed by rules as defined in The 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing and follow one-design class rules. Sailing Instructions will be available on race day.

### Scoring & Classes

A minimum of three boats of the same class (one-design) will constitute a fleet. One-design classes with fewer than three boats will be grouped into one or more Open fleets and scored using the Table of North American Portsmouth handicap ratings.

Awards will be presented after the last race as follows:

4 starters1 award5-9 starters2 awards9+ starters3 awards

### **Location**

Lake Washington Sailing Club is located at the turning basin for the Port of West Sacramento. Use Harbor blvd south to enter the Port access road and continue towards the security gate. Veer to the right of the security shack and follow signs to the sailing club.
