GALEN FREEMAN ONE DESIGN REGATTA INCLUDING CATALINA 22 REGION 3 CHAMPIONSHIP & GFOD SPRING RACE CLINIC

May 16&17 (J/22 Race Clinic) & 18-19 (Regatta), 2019

1. INVITATION--Percy Priest Yacht Club cordially invites you and your crew to attend the Galen Freeman One Design Regatta on May 18 & 19 2019.

{The regatta is be preceded by the third annual GFOD Spring Race Clinic on the afternoon of Thursday May 16 Plus on water coaching Friday May 18th 10:00 – 14:00 ... The "Race Clinic" will be open to all sailors interested in racing, however only J/22 Class boats will participate in the drills on the water. Further announcements about the Race Clinic will be available on the PPYC.org website as details emerge}

2. SITE--The regatta will be held on J. Percy Priest Lake in Nashville, Tennessee. Land based activities will be held at Hamilton Creek Sailboat Marina.

3. RULES

- 3.1. The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the Class Association Rules for each participating one design class.
- 3.2. Changes will be made to the following RRS for buoy course classes:
 29.1 (Individual Recalls), 33 (Changing the Next Leg of the Course),
 35 (Time Limit and Scores), 44 (Penalties at the Time of an Incident), 61 (Protest Requirements),
 62.1(a) (Redress), A2 (Series Scores), A4 (Low Point System),
 A5 (Scores Determined by the Race Committee), A11 (Scoring Abbreviations), and
 Race Signal AP (Postponement).
- 3.3. US Sailing Prescriptions Rule 60 (redress hearing participation), Rule 63.2 (Time and Place of the Hearing), and Rule 63.4 (Interested Party) will not apply.
- 3.4. All rule changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The regatta will be open to all one-design boats listed in paragraph 5, that are properly registered with PPYC. To be eligible to participate in the Catalina 22 Region 3 Championship the skipper/helmsperson shall be limited to Region 3 Catalina 22 racers that are current members of the C22 National Sailing Association in good standing. Participants may enter the race by registering online, or by registering on the day of the regatta at the final registration table in the Hamilton Creek Sailboat Marina building. We encourage all participants to register in advance online to help us plan for the regatta. If you register online by midnight May 14th, you will save \$20.00. If you register online, you may pay your entry fees by credit or debit card.
- 4.2. A <u>Waiver and Release of Liability and Emergency Contact Form</u> signed by the owner/skipper and each crew member must be submitted at final registration. No boat will be fully registered without submitting this (completed) form. In the event of a crew member substitution during the regatta, the new crew member must submit a signed waiver of liability to the Regatta Committee prior to racing for that boat's entry to remain valid.

5. CLASSES

- 5.1. J/22
- 5.2. Catalina 22- There will be two Catalina 22 fleets: Gold Fleet and Silver Fleet
 - Gold Fleet open to all skippers eligible to sail in the regatta. The winner will be the 2019 Region 3 Champion.
 - ii. Silver Fleet limited to skippers who have not received a first place trophy in any Catalina 22 State, Regional, or National Championship regatta.
 - iii. At least three boats are required to make a racing fleet. If less than three C22's enter Silver Fleet, all C22's will race as Gold.

6. RACING

- 6.1. As many as ten (10) races are planned over the two days.
- 6.2. One race will constitute a series.
- 6.3. No races will be started in less than three (3) knots of sustained wind as determined by the race committee.

7. COURSES

- 7.1. Courses will be as indicated in the Sailing Instructions.
- 7.2. Actual courses and course length will be determined by the Race Committee based on the sailing conditions.

8. FEES - The regatta entry fees are as follows

To participate in the regatta, you must purchase a meal package for each person on your boat. The meal package is <u>per person</u> and includes two continental breakfasts and one dinner. - 10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS--The Sailing Instructions will be available at final registration. A draft of the sailing instructions may be available for review on the PPYC regatta registration website at http://www.ppyc.org. Sailing instructions on the PPYC web site are for information purposes only and are subject to change prior to the regatta. Only sailing instructions distributed during final registration are valid.
- **11. LAUNCHING, DOCKING AND HAULING-**-Launching, docking and hauling may be done at Hamilton Creek Sailboat Marina free of charge. A ramp is available for trailer launching. No boat hoist is available.
- 12. PRIZES—<u>Each J/22</u> One Design sailboat Registered and participating in the GFOD Regatta will receive a Trophy. An additional "Performance Trophy" will be awarded to the top 5 boats. Catalina 22 Gold and Silver Fleet boats will be given trophies for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place.
- 13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER--Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. Percy Priest Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Competitors agree that the race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. As an inducement to the race organizers to produce the regatta, each competitor agrees that by participating in this event each competitor is deemed to have waived all claims against and released the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law and is deemed to have warranted that he has obtained this same release of the race organizers by each crew member.
- 14. INSURANCE--Each participating boat shall be insured by its owner with valid third-party liability insurance.
