Notice of Race

Amendment #1

Rules

Since 1947

The regatta will be governed by the *Rules* as defined in the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing, the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race.

Eligibility

This regatta is open to all boats with valid 2019 PHRF-GB certificates (spinnaker and non-spinnaker), boats entering for GBCA Club Handicap, boats that qualify for the Multihull class, and others that can form a one design class and supply a set of class rules, subject to the discretion of the race committee. Sub classes may be formed from a base class. A minimum of five boats is required to form a class. Classes which have formed by 1700 CST Friday, March 1st, 2019 will be awarded trophies as follows:

• 5-6 boats: 1st, 2nd place

• 7-9 boats: 1, 2, 3 place

• 10-12 boats: 1, 2, 3, 4 place

• 13 or more boats: 1 through 5 place

Classes which form after 1700 hours Friday, March 1st 2019 (Early Registration Deadline) are eligible for trophies, but trophies may not be available for presentation at the awards ceremony.

Competitors sailing PHRF fleets should ensure their current certificates are available on-line at www.PHRFGB.com. Certificates that are not available online should be made available to the Race Committee prior to the competitors' briefing. The entry fee will be \$75.00. Current members of GBCA will receive a \$5.00 discount. Entry fees will be refunded if the entry is withdrawn prior to the Early Registration Deadline. The deadline for all entries is Friday, March 8th 2018 at 1700 CST; however, entries received after 1700 CST, Friday, March 1st 2018 will be subject to a \$10.00 late fee.

Courses

Handicap classes are intended to have multiple large triangle windward/leeward races with 2-3nm legs Saturday and at least one triangle windward/leeward race with 2-3nm legs Sunday. One Design boats will have windward/leeward courses (length to be dependent on number of boats) run with as many as possible each day. Courses will be in the part of Galveston Bay bounded by The Bayport Ship Channel, The Houston Ship Channel and the shoreline between Red Bluff and San Leon.

Handicap classes shall be scored as Time on Time as defined by US Sailing's PHRF to Time on Time conversion.

- TCF= A/(B+PHRF)
- TCF = Time on Time handicap
- A = 650
- B = 550 for this regatta
