### **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### **1. Rules**

The Organizing Authority is Melbourne Yacht Club in conjunction with J-24 Fleet 87 and Eau Gallie Yacht Club. This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

#### **2. Eligibility**

The regatta is open to all J/24 sailboats as defined by the IJCA that possess a valid measurement certificate. Competitors must meet all ownership and class membership requirements and complete all aspects of the registration process.

#### **3. Entry and Fees**

Entry must be made on-line through Regatta Networks (URL TBA) by 1100hrs July 20, 2019.

Regatta Entry Fee: \$100.00

Registration fee includes all racing, launch/haul and social activities.

#### **4. Schedule of Events**

Friday - July 19, 2019

1900: Fleet 87 Welcome Party at Intracoastal Brewing Company

Saturday - July 20, 2019

1130: Competitor's Meeting at EGYC.

1300: Warning Signal, Race 1. (other races to follow)

After Racing Social Activities to be Announced

Sunday - July 21, 2019

0945: First Warning Signal (other races to follow)

No warning signal after 1400

Following Racing awards will be presented at EGYC

## **5. Inspection**

All boats may be subject to random inspection or measurement by the Technical Committee at any time during the Regatta for Rules Compliance and may be required to show compliance with Part D Class Measurement and Inventory of Required and Optional Equipment forms. All participants may be subject to verification of declared crew weight per Class Rules.

## **6. Sailing Instructions**

Sailing Instructions will be available at check in prior to the Competitors meeting. Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted no later than 15 minutes after the Competitors' Meeting to be effective on Saturday, July 20, 2019, or 0800 on Sunday, July 21, 2019 to be effective on that date. On-the-water changes may be made to the Sailing Instructions in accordance with Rule 89.2[c] after Flag L is displayed.

## **7. Regatta Venue**

Moorage will be available at the Eau Gallie Yacht Club but not required.

## **8. Racing Area**

The racing area will be North of the Eau Gallie Causeway on the Indian River.

## **9. Courses**

The courses will be Windward/Leeward courses with drop marks per the Sailing Instructions.

## **10. Scoring**

The Low Point scoring system RRS Appendix A will be modified such that a boat's worst score will be excluded after completion of six races. Seven (7) races are scheduled of which one (1) completed race shall constitute a Regatta. This modifies Rule A2.

## **11. Penalties**

RRS penalty rules 44.1 and 44.2, as modified in the Sailing Instructions shall apply. The scoring penalty, RRS 44.3, will not apply.

## **12. Prizes**

Prizes will be awarded for the top three places.
