NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* as modified by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2 Appendix V will be in effect.
- 1.3 The 2019 NOR for the SAYRA Youth Championship for youth classes will apply.
- 1.4 The USS prescriptions for rules 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all one-design and PHRF boats with 3 or more boats registered.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing a registration form and payment of fees.

3 FEES

- 3.1 Required fees are as follows:

Early Registration (Prior to October 1)

Adults \$45.00

Juniors \$30.00

Late Registration (October 1-12)

Adults-\$60.00

Juniors-\$40.00

- 3.2 Early registration comes with a regatta t-shirt.
- 3.3 Beer bracelets, meals, and additional shirts are available at storefront.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1* Early registration ends at 11:59 p.m. on September 30. On-site registration is available on Friday, October 11th from 4:30-7:30 pm and 8:00-10:00 am on Saturday, October 12th.
- 4.2 You are required to check-in at the registration desk prior to 10:00 am on October 12th.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at the registration desk on October 11th and 12th.

6 PENALTY SYSTEM

6.1 Rules V1 and V2 of Appendix V will be explained in the sailing instructions.

7 SCORING

7.1 An unlimited number of races are scheduled on all courses. One complete race will constitute a regatta.

7.2 The regatta will be scored with the low point system as described in RRS, Appendix A as amended to read that if 6 or more races are scored, each boat will exclude her worst score.

8 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats will be on the water to provide safety and will also carry water available to competitors.

9 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: 1st-3rd place trophies will be awarded for each class having 6 or more boats. All Green Fleet Opti sailors will be recognized.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
