

# 2018 SCYC CLIFF McNamara Champion of Champions Invitational Sunday, April 7, 2019

#### SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

#### 1 Rules

- 1.1 This Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3 Appendix A2 is changed per Sailing Instruction 11.2.

#### 2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This is an Invitational Regatta for boats that have won a class in a SCYC series or regatta in the 2018 season or the 2018/2019 Midwinters regatta.
- 2.2. Eligible boats must enter on-line at scyc.org/racing prior to 1200 April 7, 2019.
- 2.3 A boat is not entered until her Regatta Entry Form is signed.
- 2.4 The entry fee is \$35 and is non-refundable.

#### **3** Communication with Competitors

- 3.1 A Competitors' Meeting will take place at 1100 on Sunday, April 7, 2019 at the SCYC Clubhouse. Official Notices will be posted on the Official Regatta Notice Board located in the window at the Northeast corner of the clubhouse.
- 3.2 Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted by 1100 hours on race day. Signals made ashore will be displayed from the yardarm of the mast on the SCYC clubhouse deck.
- 3.3 On the water the Race Committee will use VHF 68 for communication.

### 4 Schedule

- 4.1 One race is scheduled.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1255 hours.
- 4.3 An awards ceremony will take place at the SCYC Clubhouse following the regatta. The overall winner based on finish position will be designated the 2018 Cliff McNamara Champion of Champions and will have the boat name affixed to the perpetual trophy.

#### 5 Racing Area

The racing area will be within a three mile radius from the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.


#### 6 The Course

- 6.1 The courses and marks are described on Attachment A Description of Marks and Courses.
- 6.2 Courses will be signaled with a numerical pennant.

#### 7 The Start

- 7.1 The class flag shall be Code Flag F.
- 7.2 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee signal boat and a nearby red mark.

#### 8 Recalls

8.1 The Race Committee may hail the sail number(s) of the boat(s) identified on the course side of the starting line by VHF radio after the starting signal. The failure of a hail, the failure of a boat to hear the hail, or the order of the hails shall not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

#### 9 The Finish

9.1 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee signal boat and a nearby red mark.

#### 10 Protests

- 10.1 US SAILING Protest Forms will be available at the SCYC Regatta Shed. The filing period for protests shall expire one hour after the Race Committee Signal Boat docks.
- The time and place of all protest hearing(s), the boat(s) protesting, boat(s) being protested and boat(s) requesting redress will be posted on the Official Regatta Notice Board within 90 minutes after the docking of the Race Committee Signal Boat. This shall serve as notification as per RRS 63.2.

#### 11 Scoring


- 11.1 One race shall constitute the series.
- 11.2 No scores will be excluded. This changes RRS A2.

#### 12 Awards

12.1 The overall winner based on finish position will be designated the 2018 Cliff McNamara Champion of Champions and will have the boat name affixed to the perpetual trophy.

## Attachment A – Description of Marks and Courses

### **COURSE ROUNDING ORDER**

- 1 Start W(p) Finish
- 2 Start -W(p) L(p) W(p) Finish
- 3 Start -W(p) L(p) W(p) L(p) W(p) Finish
- Start -W(p) L(p) W(p) L(p) W(p) L(p) W(p)- Finish p = port rounding

### MARK DESCRIPTION

- **Start** The Starting Line will be between a staff on the race committee signal boat displaying an orange flag and a nearby red mark.
  - W Orange Inflatable Tetrahedron set as a Windward Mark.
  - L Yellow Inflatable Tetrahedron set as a Leeward Mark set to windward of the Start Line.
- **Finish** The finish line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee Signal Boat and a nearby orange mark. The finish line will be in the vicinity of Mark L.
