Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2. RRS 55 is changed by adding the following sentence to the rule: "However, discarding biodegradable bands when setting a sail is permitted." Racers remain responsible for compliance with all applicable state and federal laws.
- 1.3. US Sailing **Nearshore** Safety Equipment is required in addition to all required USCG boating requirements. https://www.ussailing.org/wp-content/uploads/2018/03/US_SER_2018.0_Categories.pdf
- 1.4. International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea or government right-of-way rules shall replace Section 2 of RRS between sunset and sunrise. Attention is called to RRS 48 concerning fog signals and lights.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. This race is open to all racing boats greater than 20' LOA and designed and built to go offshore and who hold a valid rating certificate for the fleet in which they are entered (except for the Cruising Class).

3. ENTRY

- 3.1. Timely entries shall be submitted on-line via Regatta Network website: Link will be located at <http://sandiegocoastalcup.com/>
- 3.2. Entry Deadline is 1700 Thursday, May 23, 2019.
- 3.3. Non-PHRF San Diego entries must include a copy of their rating certificate.

3.4. Butler Handicap Fleet entries are requested to include a copy of their rating certificate, if available.

4. FEES

4.1. Registration fees for The San Diego Coastal Cup, which includes both the Butler Invitational and the OYC to SWYC races are as follows:

<30 ft LOA	\$55.00
30-40 ft LOA	\$75.00
40+ LOA	\$105.00

4.2. Registration includes Friday and Saturday night party entry, water taxi for registered competitors and crew, and slip fees in Oceanside Harbor for Saturday night. Food options for the weekend will be extra and details will be available on the website.

5. CLASSES

5.1. PHRF Classes will be determined by the OA and will be the same for both races. Official class assignments will be established and posted on the websites no later than 1200 Friday, May 24th, 2019. Provisional assignments MAY be posted earlier.

5.2. One Design classes with 4 or more entries before the entry deadline.

5.3. Cruising Classes, both spinnaker and non-spinnaker. Boats in the Cruising Class must have a PHRF RLC base rating greater than 45 and a Performance Factor less than 1.8. Ratings will be reviewed, and assigned, if necessary, by the Organizing Authority.

5.4. SWRF, Southwestern Racing Fleet.

5.5. MBYC Butler Handicap Fleet for those yachts not in section 5.1-5.4.

6. SCORING

6.1. The series races will be scored with the Low-Point System as provided in Appendix A of the RRS.

6.2. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

6.3. If fewer than two races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race score.

6.4. PHRF Classes shall be scored using PHRF San Diego Random Leg Course ratings using Time on Distance. Yachts racing under SoCal PHRF Certificates shall use their area "G" rating.

6.5. SWRF will use SWRF ratings supplied by SWYC Racing Fleet.

6.6. MBYC Butler Handicap Fleet will use San Diego PHRF RLC ratings.

7. COURSES

Saturday

7.1. Start approximately 1nm NNW of Mission Bay entrance.

7.2. Leave Windward Mark to starboard, located approximately 1nm directly upwind.

7.3. Finish approximately 500 yards directly west of the Oceanside Pier.

7.4. Approximate course length will be 27.4nm

Sunday

7.5. Start approximately 500 yards directly west of the Oceanside Pier.

7.6. Course 1: Leave San Diego Channel Buoy SD to port, Finish near end of Zuniga. Approximate length 38nm.

7.7. Course 2: Finish approximately 1nm NNW of Mission Bay entrance Approximate length 26.8nm.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 8.1. Sailing Instructions will be available on the regatta website no later than 1900 , Thursday, May 23, 2019.
- 8.2. Notices to competitors will be posted on the regatta event web site, <http://sandiegocoastalcup.com/> no later than 0900 hours on the day of the event.

9. SCHEDULE

- 9.1. Entry Deadline is 1700 Thursday, May 23, 2019.
- 9.2. The Warning signal on Saturday, May 25, 2019 will be 1125 hours for the first class.
- 9.3. The Warning signal on Sunday May 26, 2019 class will be 1100 hours for the first class.

- 9.5. **Saturday May 26th** – Butler Race to Oceanside. Food and beverage available for purchase. Limited shuttle service available between MBYC and boats anchored in Mariners cove.
- 9.6. Limited guest parking for crew of registered yachts allowed at MBYC Friday evening for the party and Saturday morning for crew drop off only. Due to the Memorial Holiday weekend guest parking is not allowed for the duration of the weekend. Please consider using uber/lyft/cab service.
- 9.7. **Limited complimentary round-trip boat Shuttle service** will be provided so that crew of registered competing yachts may come to MBYC Friday night for the party. Additionally, we will arrange Saturday morning shuttles to get competitors to their yachts from MBYC Sat morning. To sign up for this service please select the option on the registration forms. Additional information will be sent to those yachts who have signed up for the shuttle option.
