



# 2019 ECSC Mayor's Cup Notice of Race May 18-19, 2019



1. **Rules:** The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and changed as follows:
  - a. **RRS 29.2 General Recall** is modified to allow the race committee to use any amount of time it wishes after the lowering of the general recall flag before resuming racing operations.
2. **Eligibility:** The regatta is open to any sailboat of 26 feet in length or less.
3. **Entry:** To be eligible to race, competitors must register and pay the appropriate fees either online through [www.regattanetwork.com](http://www.regattanetwork.com) on or before Wednesday May 15, 2019 or in person at the registration table by 10:00 AM on May 18, 2019. Boats racing in PHRF handicap fleet must have an ECSC PHRF Handicap Form on file with ECSC Racing. (Available at registration and online at <http://www.ecsail.org/racing.htm>). **Fleets requesting a separate start must have at least five boats pre-registered.**
4. **Fleets (subject to pre-registration):**
  - a) Highlander, b) Flying Scott, c) S27.9, d) J24, e) J22, f) 3 PHRF Fleets
 Individual starts for one design classes with 5 boats pre-registered. Fleets of less than 5 boats may be combined at the discretion of the Race Director.
5. **Fees:** Registration fee is \$60 (Includes 1 shirt and 1 meal pkg.). Full meal packages may be purchased for \$15 per person on line or at the registration table. Meal package includes: Continental Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday; plus, dinner on Saturday and lunch Sunday after racing. T-shirts are available for \$20(pre-orders please by May 12th). 8. **Venue:** Eagle Creek Sailing Club – 8901 West 46<sup>th</sup> Street, Indianapolis, IN
9. **Courses:** Courses shall be provided in the Sailing Instructions
10. **Scoring:** See SI
11. **Awards:** Mayor's Cup Trophy (Stays on site w/name inscribed) will be awarded to the boat with the lowest total score in **the largest fleet**. In the event of a tie for largest fleet, the fleet with the most out of town boats shall be awarded the Mayor's Cup. If there is still a tie, then a coin flip will decide which fleet is awarded the Mayor's Cup. In the event of a tie within the fleet, RRS Appendix A8.1 will be applied.
  - a. Fleets with 4 or more pre-registered boats will receive First, Second and Third Place awards.
  - b. Fleets with 3 pre-registered boats will receive First and Second place awards.
  - c. Fleets with 2 pre-registered boats will receive First place award.
