

Racing Yacht Fleets Series Chicago Yacht Club (OA) Belmont Harbor, Chicago, IL May 25 - September 28, 2019

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Appendix V1 and V2 will apply.
- 1.3 Class rules prohibiting the use of marine band radios and cellular telephones will not apply. All boats are required to carry an operating VHF marine-band radio while sailing in these events. This changes International Etchells Class Rule C.5.2(b)(8) and Shields Class Rule 10.9.
- 1.4 Class rules prohibiting GPS navigation devices will not apply. The following conditions shall apply to the use of GPS navigation devices: when class rules prohibit the use of a GPS while racing, such a device may be used provided that it is installed in a position or covered in such a way that no data may be taken from it while sailing. Data produced by such device may be viewed only at the dock or on shore. This changes International Etchells Class Rules C.5.2(b)(8) and Shields Class Rule 10.9.
- 1.5 Class rule I.1 (spare gennaker) is invoked for the J/70 class.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The Racing Yachts Fleets Series is open on dates shown on the Addendum A Schedule to the following boats:

30' and Under (International Etchells, Luders, Shields, Sonars, J/70, J/88)

31' to 40' (Tartan 10, J/105, J/111, Beneteau 36.7, Farr 40)

Owner must also be an active member in good standing of the boat's class and local Chicago fleet. minimum of 3 boats must be entered to be considered a CYC fleet by the scheduled first race of the respective class.

- 2.2 To be eligible for Chicago Yacht Club member fees, a boat shall be owned, co-owned, or chartered by a Chicago Yacht Club member or pending applicant, and such owner, co-owner, charterer, or pending applicant or a designated representative who is a Chicago Yacht Club member shall be on board while racing in Series races.

- 2.4 Entries must be completed before 2359 Thursday prior to any entered race.

4 SCHEDULE AND VENUE

- 4.1 ONLY scheduled races are listed in Addendum A.
- 4.2 The races will be held in the open waters of Lake Michigan east of Belmont Harbor.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1055.
- 4.4 No warning signal shall be initiated after 1500.
- 4.5 Information about participation in the Columbia Yacht Club Colors Regatta is listed in Addendum B.
- 4.6 Information about participation in the Chicago Yacht Club Stripes Regatta is listed in Addendum C.
- 4.7 Information about participation in the Chicago Yacht Club Sheldon Clark Regatta is listed in Addendum D.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the first scheduled event on the official notice board at the Chicago Yacht Club Belmont Station and, as a courtesy, on the event website at: https://www.chicagoyachtclub.org/regattas/racing-yacht-fleet-series

6 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Dry-sail hoists shall not be used for boat cleaning, maintenance or repairs between 0900 and 1130 on the day that any dry-sailed class has a morning start. A boat breaking this rule may receive a scoring penalty in that day's series races of up to 40% (rounding 0.5 upward) of the boats entered in the series.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 The series will be scored using a high point scoring system. *This changes RRS A2*.
- 7.2 The high point scoring system is defined as the following:

Each boat will receive point(s) equal to the number of boats she beat, plus one point. The end season score will be the sum of all the points of the individual races. **There will be no exclusions (throw outs).** A skipper may miss up to one RYF race day during the season to attend one sanctioned regatta out of town and will be awarded one point for each RYF race missed that day. At the end of the season, the boat with the most points will be awarded first place, etc.

DNC - DID NOT COMPETE

Boats that did not come to the starting area will receive 0 points.

DNS – DID NOT START OTHER THAN DNC AND OCS

Boats that did not start other than DNC and OCS will receive 0 points.

OCS – DID NOT START; ON THE COURSE SIDE OF THE START LINE

Boats that were on the course side of the starting line will receive 1 point. OCS boats will be counted as racing or raced.

DNF – DID NOT FINISH

Boats that did not finish will receive 1 point. She started and will be counted as racing or raced.

DSQ – DISQUALIFICATION

Boats that were disqualified will receive 0 points. DSQ boats will be counted as racing or raced.

RCD – RACE COMMITTEE DUTY

A boat that does Race Committee will receive average points for that day.
