DANA WEST YACHT CLUB CHARITY REGATTA
May 31, June 1st & 2nd, 2019
The Organizing Authority is the DWYC

The Dana West Yacht Club Annual Charity Regatta benefitting the American Cancer Society invite you to a Regatta where all sailors can race for trophies and raise funds for the American Cancer Society.

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing* and the US Safety Equipment Regulations, Near Shore Category, except as modified by this notice of race and sailing instructions. The equipment requirements are available at:

1.2 RRS 29.2 - *General Recall, Race Signals – AP*, is changed to:

In the event of a general recall, the re-called class will start five minutes after the last scheduled class. This changes RRS 29.2.

1.3 The US Sailing prescriptions to rules 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

2. ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising on a boat shall comply with the requirements of ISAF Regulation 20.

2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA.

3. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the window adjacent to the front entrance of the Dana West Yacht Club (DWYC). This will be the Regatta's Official Notice Board.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 This regatta is open to all eligible monohulls. Boats enter by submitting a complete entry form online at DWYC Race www.dwyc.org/racing or Regatta Network https://www.regattanetwork.com/clubmgmt/applet_registration_form.php?regatta_id=18740 and paying the applicable entry fee to DWYC. No later Wednesday May 29, 2019.

4.2 Late entries may be accepted. A late fee of \$20.00 will be charged to late entries.

4.3 All PHRF entrants will be scored with their PHRF regular rating. Any boat entered without a rating will be determined by the Organization Authority. Any boat entered without rating will one assigned by the AO whose decision will not be subject to redress. OA Additional rating adjustments will apply through fund raising efforts by each boat (see donation schedule on the Event Time Adjustment Form). Note the Event Time Adjustment Form and Pledge Sheet maybe printed off, completed and scanned as a document, uploaded with entry or manually submitted to the DWYC Race Chair, www.race@DWYC.org , (the Event Time Adjustment Form must be submitted with the official entry, note the pledge sheet maybe submitted by 1800 June 1, 2019). OA whose decision will not be subject to redress.

5. FEES

- 5.1 The entry fee is \$90.00. US Sailing Member Fee is \$ 85.00. Valid USSA Membership Card is required.
- 5.2 Credit Card payment on the entry form is the preferred method. If paying by check, please make it payable to Dana West Yacht Club.
- 5.3 Pledge sheets, for those who wish to participate in fundraising, must be submitted by 1800 on June 1st, 2019.

6. CLASSES

- 6.1 PHRF class will be scored using the ratings of the PHRF of So Cal.
- 6.2 Non-Spinnaker class entries not submitting a certificate will be rated by the Organization Authority whose decision will not be subject to redress.

7. SCHEDULE

Sunday	June 2 nd	1 Random-Leg races (PHRF-Regular & Non-Spinnaker)	Start at 1230

8. COMPETITORS MEETING

- 8.1 Competitors Meeting is scheduled for Saturday, June 1, 2019 at 0930 at the DWYC.
- 8.2 Sailing Instructions will be available on the DWYC Web site no later than May 27, 2019.
We strongly encourage for each boat to print the NOR and when available, the SI and any Amendments published. Race package and race entries will be available at Dana West Yacht Club on Thursday May 30, 2019 at 1800.
- 8.3 A boat representative must pick up their race package prior to 0900 on Friday, May 31, 2019. If you have difficulty in picking up the race package as required above, call to make alternative plans. A representative of the boat must complete this alternative arrangement prior to the deadline of May 31, 2019 by 0900.

9. COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows:

Newport to Dana Point. For scoring purposes, the course length will be 12 nm.
Drop Buoy and Random Leg races, in the vicinity of Dana Point Harbor.

10. SCORING

- 10.1 Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A.
- 10.2 PHRF-Regular Base OWC ratings will be used for the Friday race. For Saturday races the PHRF Buoy ratings will be used for Buoy races and PHRF- RLC ratings will be used for Random-Leg races. Adjustments to the rating will be made if participating with Fund Raising, noted in paragraph 4.3.
- 10.3 For Non-Spinnaker classes Base OWC rating will be used for Friday race. PHRF Ratings RLC will be applied for the Saturday and Sunday RLC, adjustments to ratings may be made to an entered boat through the Event Time Adjustment Form. All entrants are eligible to participate with Fund Raising, noted in paragraph 4.3.

11. RADIO COMMUNICATION

The Race Committee will make use of VHF radios to keep sailors informed of Start Times, On Course Side (OCS), Postponements and other information regarding the racing.

Except in an emergency, a boat shall not make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

Communication restrictions with respect to RRS 41 – Outside Help: attention is drawn to USSA Question 93 from the US Sailing Appeals Committee. This interpretation clarifies the application of RRS 41 and governs competitor’s actions during the race.

12 AWARDS

12.1 There will be daily and perpetual awards.

For PHRF classes, three (3) races are required to qualify for the class trophies, but four races (4) will be counted for the Wesley Hawkins Bowl. Total will be reduced if any scheduled races are abandoned and not re-sailed.

For Cruising Fleet, two (2) races are required to qualify for the class trophies, but three (3) races will be counted for the Jim Ferguson Trophy. Total will be reduced if any scheduled races are abandoned and not re-sailed.

13. RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in the DWYC Charity Regatta, a competitor automatically grants to the organizers and its sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show from time to time at their discretion, any still or motion pictures and live, taped, or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her without compensation.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, RA, RC, PC, host clubs, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor’s participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law. Pursuant to Circular 230 and to assure compliance with the Treasury Department, nothing contained herein is intended to convey tax advice.

15. Amendments to this Notice

OA reserves the right to amend this Notice of Race. The Notice of Race and any Amendments will be posted on www.race@dwyc.org

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000.00 per incident.
