Eligibility: The regatta is open to any boat in the following classes:

PHRF A0	PHRF C	J/30
PHRF A1	PHRF NS	J/105
PHRF A2	Cal 25	CHESSS (spinnaker and non-spinnaker)
PHRF B	J/24	CRCA ^o (all classes)

^o – Denotes event does not qualify for CBYRA High Point

Rendezvous: At 1600 in vicinity of Hackett Point GC¹ (Region 3 Annapolis Area Mark “A”).

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: Between yellow or orange flag on Race Committee boat and nearby inflatable or government mark.
The first warning signal is scheduled for 1700. The planned starting sequence is:

*Yachts in classes having few entries will be combined to ensure all yachts will be competing for at least one award at the discretion of the race committee

** The Race Committee will use a white streamer for all CRCA sub-classes

*** The Race Committee will use a green streamer for the CHESS class

Signals: RRS 26 “Starting Races”.

Event Sailing Instructions will be available on the SSC website www.shearwatersc.net not later than 1700 on Friday 14 June 2019.

- Course:** Annapolis Area Region 3 standard racing marks as designated by letters displayed on Race Committee boat. The Race Committee may shorten the course.
- Finish:** Between yellow or orange flag on Race Committee boat and last mark of course.
- Time Limit:** Midnight for all classes. Boats not finishing within one hour of the first boat in their class to finish will be scored TLE and awarded points equal to the number of finishers plus two, but in no case more than the number of starters. This changes RRS 35 and A4.1.
- Scoring:** PHRF and CHESS will be scored using PHRF of the Chesapeake Random Leg ratings. CRCA classes will use class-designated ratings.
- Protests:** Mail to SSC Race Committee, at address above, postmarked no later than Monday 17 June 2019. Hearing will be held at a time and place to be announced.
- Awards:** 1st/3, 2nd/5, 3rd/7 & 4th/10+ starters. Additional awards may be given at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- Other:** IMPERATIVE: Each yacht is responsible for following the *CBYRA General Sailing Instructions* for racing and finishing at night.
Registration will be open for CRCA classes: ORRez: Cruiser, Non-Spinnaker, Performance Cruiser, Pocket Cruiser, and Assigned rating: Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker.
