



SAILING INSTRUCTIONS
BAY SHORE YACHT CLUB'S
JUNIOR NON-CONVENTIONAL TEAM REGATTA
SATURDAY, JULY 27

1. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:**
 - 1.1 This event is open to all Junior sailors (age 16 and under)
 - 1.2 This event is a team format. Each Team shall consist of three boats- one 420 with 2 sailors, one Sunfish with 1 sailor, and one Opti with 1 sailor. Competitors should try to form teams before the event, but if they are unable to join a team prior to the event, they will be assigned to one by the race committee
 - 1.3 Competitors must register either via email to billray407@aol.com or in person using the sign-up sheet in the Junior Yacht Club Room at BSYC.
2. **SCHEDULE Saturday, July 27**

3. **RACING AREA** is Great South Bay immediately to the south of Bay Shore Yacht Club
 4. **RACES:** Three races are planned but the committee may cancel any one of them at their discretion.
 5. **Race 1: WHIRLWIND RACE:** Each competitor shall perform a 360 maneuver on each leg of the course. The boat may perform the 360 anywhere on the leg, but must stay clear of all boats while performing it. Each of the 3 classes shall be started separately.
Race 2: PASS THE BATON RACE: This is a team relay race. Opti's shall start first, followed by the Sunfish and then the 420's. Specific instructions will be given at the skippers meeting. This race shall be used only for team prize scoring.
Race3: POKER RUN: Competitors shall collect one playing card at each mark on the course. The best poker hand will determine the order of finish. Prizes will be awarded for individual hand first and then the team my pool their cards for the team prize.
6. **COURSES:** As Shown in Appendix A. The START ----- FINISH line is an obstruction except when Starting or Finishing.
7. **THE START:** Whistle starts shall be used for all races
8. **SAFETY REGULATIONS:** US Coast Guard approved life preservers shall be worn at all times while afloat except for brief periods when adding or removing clothing.
9. **PRIZES:** Will be awarded for both team and Individual performances. Prizes will also be awarded for the creative team – base don name and attire.
10. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. Bay Shore Yacht Club, its officers, employees, governors, agents, members, committees and volunteers will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the Regatta.

Start - 1 - 2 - 3 - Finish

All marks shall be left to PORT

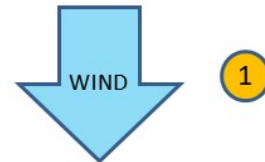
MARKS

Orange Hip-Hop Buoys

NOTES

For the **PASS THE BATON** race, the finishing boat shall drop the baton upwind of the start-finish line and the next boat must start and pick it up before proceeding around the course. Boats finishing shall not interfere with boats retrieving batons

For the **POKER RUN** race, boats shall pick up a card at the RC boat before starting and after finishing. They shall also pick up cards at boats stationed at Marks 1, 2 and 3 for a total of 5 cards.



The Start/Finish Line is an **OBSTRUCTION** except when starting or finishing
